Malcolm de Roubaix is a retired anaesthesiologist with doctorates in medicine and applied ethics (bioethics). He has published more than thirty peer-reviewed articles in journals of philosophy, applied ethics medical law, and medicine.

He has written three book chapters and two books, including *Hoop, Heling en Harmonie: Dink nuut oor siekte en genesing*, written in his home language, Afrikaans, which won the 2021 Andrew Murray Book Prize. Cambridge Scholars published his book *Responsible Reproductive Choice in the 21st Century* in 2023.

Amongst others, he has chaired a research ethics committee of the Faculty of Medicine, University of Stellenbosch, and is currently a Research Fellow of the Centre for Applied Ethics at the university's Department of Philosophy.
