Dr. Chatora earned an honours degree from the University of Zimbabwe.

After five years of radiology training in Nottingham, he became a Royal College of Radiologists fellow in 2010. A two-year Nottingham Interventional Radiology and Sheffield Academic Vascular Institute subspecialty residency followed.

After returning to Zimbabwe in 2013, Dr. Chatora founded the first interventional radiology clinic. He has conducted over 8,000 interventional procedures to date, including microwave tumour ablation and fibroid embolisation, changing patient treatment in the country.

He is the Clinical Director at MIC Radiology Group, the only vascular and non-vascular interventional radiology practice and is currently the only subspecialty-trained interventional radiologist in the country.
