Keymanthri Moodley is an Emeritus Professor at Stellenbosch University and an Adjunct Professor in the Department of Social Medicine, University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, USA. She is a specialist family physician, bioethicist, an NRF rated researcher and a member of the Academy of Science of South Africa (ASSAf). To date, she has served as Principal Investigator on 5 NIH grants and has over 140 publications (journals, books, book chapters).

She currently co-chairs the WHO Working Group on Developing Guidance for Clinical Ethics. Her most recent NIH funded research project explored ethical, legal and social issues (ELSI) in Big Data and Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Africa. Keymanthri is a member of the WHO Ethics and AI Expert Group.
