Donald P. Frush MD, is the John Strohbehn Professor of Radiology, and Associate Faculty Member, Medical Physics Graduate Program at Duke University Medical Center.

Dr. Frush earned his undergraduate degree from U.C. Davis, MD from Duke School of Medicine, was a pediatric resident at U.C. San Francisco, completed a radiology residency at Duke and a fellowship in pediatric radiology at Children's Hospital in Cincinnati.

Dr. Frush's research interests are predominantly pediatric body CT including technology assessment, techniques for pediatric CT examinations, assessment of image quality, radiation dosimetry, and radiation protection and risk communication in medical imaging.
