Bernard is the current President of IRPA (2021-2024). After training as a medical doctor, his career pathway has given him the opportunity to gain experience in hospital, research, nuclear operations, and expertise in nuclear safety and radiation protection.

He is a senior expert for Radiation Protection and Health at group level EDF and has been called on as an expert at international level (the IAEA, ICR, WHO, OECD, EPRI...)

He has published over 150 national and international articles. He is the leader of the joint IRPA, WHO, IAEA initiative on the Radiation Safety Culture in health care.

Dr le Guen received two awards from the American health physics society in recognition of his international research in radiation protection, the William Morgan Award and the R.S. Landauer Award. Dr Le Guen was appointed international member of the Royal Academy of Medicine of Zaragoza (Spain Institute) in 2021.
