Coenie Koegelenberg is a clinician-researcher and Head of the Division of Pulmonology, Department of Medicine, at Stellenbosch University and Tygerberg Hospital. His research interests have included lung cancer, infectious and pleural diseases, preoperative assessment of lung resection candidates, applied transthoracic ultrasound, interventional pulmonology, critical care and more recently COVID-19. Coenie is the author of more than 200 peer-reviewed papers and 19 textbook chapters, most on transthoracic ultrasound, pleural and infectious diseases. He was also extensively involved in numerous guidelines for the management of common respiratory diseases. Coenie Koegelenberg is a past president of the South African Thoracic Society (SATS) and one of the founding members and current chairman of Interventional Pulmonology South Africa (IPSA).
