Dr Claire Robinson is a consultant radiographer in post-mortem imaging at University Hospitals of Leicester NHS Trust, UK and senior lecturer at the University of Leicester, UK. She has been involved in forensic imaging and research for more than 20 years specialising in the use of CT in post-mortem investigations. Claire has a varied experience including helping to develop targeted coronary artery PMCT angiography techniques and completed whole body angiography research locally and as part of an international study. Claire has also been heavily involved in developing the use of CT in mass fatality incidents (disaster victim identification) and has been deployed to over 20 incidents. Claire regularly presents at national and international conferences, teaches on PM imaging courses and has over 40 publications on forensic imaging. She was awarded her PhD in July 2021 and was honoured with an MBE for services to forensic investigations in May 2023.
