Dr Chadia Rizk holds a Ph.D. in Radiation Protection and Medical Physics. Currently, she serves as a Radiation Protection Specialist at the International Atomic Energy Agency since 2023. Previously, she was the Vice Chairperson of the Steering Committee of the Asia and the Pacific Regional ALARA Network (ARAN) from 2021 to 2023 and worked with the Regulatory Authority at the Lebanese Atomic Energy Commission from 2005 to 2023.

Dr Rizk was responsible for the Individual Monitoring Laboratory at the Lebanese Atomic Energy Commission - National Council for Scientific Research of Lebanon from 2005 to 2023. Since 2016, she has been a lecturer for the IAEA, focusing on dosimetry, occupational and medical radiation protection, and ISO/IEC 17025:2005 requirements. She has also served as a part-time professor at Saint Joseph University and La Sagesse University in Lebanon. Dr Rizk has mentored several Ph.D. and master's students in radiation protection, participated in numerous international conferences, and authored over 20 scientific publications in the field of medical and occupational radiation protection.
