Dr Kevin Anton is an Assistant Professor in the Division of Vascular & Interventional Radiology at Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia, PA, USA where he has been a faculty member since 2019.

Dr Anton's clinical practice and research focus on interventional oncology, contrast-enhanced ultrasound, and embolization, including genicular artery embolization. He has active research projects involving locoregional treatment in oncology (HCC, cholangiocarcinoma, and renal cell carcinoma), genicular artery embolization for chronic knee pain, and the use of geospatial analysis to understand the postpartum haemorrhage landscape in Kenya to improve maternal morbidity and mortality.

He is the Associate Director of IR at RAD-AID International and is an active adjunct faculty member in the IR fellowship program at the University of Nairobi, working closely with Dr Bob Dixon. He is actively supporting IR programs in Kenya, Guyana, Nigeria, Indonesia, and Nepal. In addition, he is the Director of the Global Radiology elective, radiology international observership program, and RAD-AID chapter at Jefferson.
