



Prof Hans Strijdom

Hans Strijdom is a clinician-turned-academic, and currently Professor and Head of the Division of Medical Physiology and Deputy Director of the Centre for Cardio-metabolic Research in Africa at Stellenbosch University, South Africa. His broader research focuses on the physiology and pathophysiology of the cardiovascular system, with a particular interest in vascular and endothelial biology. He has previously collaborated on studies investigating the physiological effects of extracts from the indigenous Honeybush (*Cyclopia maculata*) and Rooibos (*Aspalathus linearis*) plant species found in South Africa, and is currently investigating the interaction between HIV and cardio-metabolic changes in people living with HIV.
