Dr Landes has been a Consultant Paediatric Radiologist at Alder Hey Children's NHS Trust since 2006. Dr Landes's expertise within paediatric radiology covers the full range of paediatric imaging including plain x-ray, ultrasound, fluoroscopy, cross-sectional imaging (CT and MRI) and nuclear medicine.

Dr Landes has a special interest in musculoskeletal radiology and trauma, in particular imaging in non-accidental injury. She is the radiology lead for the regular child protection, rheumatology, orthopaedic and skeletal dysplasia multidisciplinary meetings at Alder Hey Children's NHS Foundation Trust.

Dr Landes is the Alder Hey Radiology Trauma lead and was invited to contribute to the recently published RCR guidance on imaging in paediatric trauma. She is also a founder member and a paediatric contributor to the British Society of Emergency Medicine.

As a result of her expertise, she has been an invited speaker at a number of national and international conferences and has received national referrals for review of musculoskeletal imaging from Radiologists and Clinicians with an emphasis on imaging in cases of suspected non-accidental injury. Dr Landes has also given expert advice in hundreds of child protection cases.
