





Getting to Manchester

Manchester Metropolitan University is well served by motorways, and has good public transport.

The university campus is close to Manchester's city centre. The routes most used by students and staff are well served by public transport. There's a free shuttle bus that covers the city centre, linking the main railway stations, NCP car parks, and bus and Metrolink tram stops.

The Conference is based at The Business School, located on the All Saints campus. To work out which part of the campus you are visiting download the [campus map](#).



Manchester International Airport to Manchester Metropolitan University is around 20 minutes via taxi.



To use the visitor car park at All Saints campus, please use the postcode M1 5SH or follow this [link](#). The visitor car park is beneath Mancunian Way, next to Oxford Road. To use the visitor car park at Birley, please use the postcode M15 6GX or follow this [link](#). The visitor car park is the surface car park adjacent to the building.



The All Saints area of the Manchester campus is just a 5-minute walk from Oxford Road Station. There are regular regional trains from Oxford Road and the station is operated by Northern Rail. Piccadilly Station is connected to local, regional and national rail services and via the West Coast Mainline. You can walk to the campus in 15-20 minutes from Piccadilly Station. Alternatively, take the 147 bus to Oxford Road. The 147 bus runs every 10-15 minutes throughout the working day.
