



All packages include refreshments during the day.



The Brighton Centre Kings Road, Brighton and Hove, Brighton BN1 2GR

The conference and exhibition will take place at The Brighton Centre, the largest purpose built events venue on the South Coast. Located on the city's iconic seafront, the centre is easy to get to by public transport, being just a 10-15 minute walk from Brighton Station.

We are holding a number of hotel rooms at the Grand Hotel, Brighton which is the Event HQ. These can be booked via the portal.



Brighton and Additional Industry Activities

The Brighton Centre

It is the largest conference and exhibition centre of its kind in the south of England. Situated on Brighton seafront, the Brighton Centre was built between 1975 and 1976 and opened on September 19, 1977.





Gatwick Airport to Brighton by train is around 30 minutes Heathrow Airport to Brighton by train is around 2 hours



Driving to Brighton & Hove is simple with the A27 connecting the city to the East & the West and the M23 / A23 linking Brighton to the capital. We do however suggest travelling by train and parking is restricted in the city.



London St Pancras International - Direct train 1 hour 20 minutes London Victoria - Direct train 50 minutes London Bridge - Direct train 1 hour

Brighton Station is 0.5 miles from the venue, an approx 7-10 minute walk Exit the station on Queens Road and walk straight down past the Clock Tower, as far as you can without going into the sea! Turn right onto the King's Road and we are 1 minute along the seafront!

Additional Industry Activities

We appreciate that many of you plan extra activities with the BESS delegates around the Conference. We encourage this engagement but would appreciate it if this could take place on Friday evening and/or Saturday morning for delegates to extend their stay. Alternatively, the Wednesday evening is also a free night for most delegates with the exception of those attending the Presidents Dinner.
