Warsaw is one of Europe's most dynamic and fast-developing capitals, combining a rich and complex history with modern architecture, vibrant culture and a strong international reputation. Over the past years, the city has been consistently recognised in global rankings and leading international media, including Forbes and New York Times, as one of the most attractive and liveable cities in Europe.

The city has earned prestigious international titles such as Best European Destination 2023 and European Capital of MICE and Leisure 2026, confirming Warsaw's strong position as a leading destination for both leisure travel and business events. Its continuously expanding infrastructure, modern hotels, creative venues and professional services make Warsaw one of the most competitive city destinations in Europe.

Warsaw offers an impressive mix of attractions: a beautifully reconstructed UNESCO-listed Old Town, royal residences such as Wilanów Palace and Royal Castle, worldclass museums, contemporary architecture and lively neighbourhoods full of cafés, boutiques and cultural venues. The city is also known for its fast, safe and efficient public transport system, excellent connectivity and easy access from international airports and rail hubs.

One of Warsaw's greatest strengths is its outstanding culinary scene. The city is home to several restaurants listed in the MICHELIN Guide, as well as one of the largest and most diverse vegan scenes in Europe, making it an ideal destination for groups with varied dietary preferences. From fine dining to modern food halls and local concepts, Warsaw offers a gastronomic experience at the highest level.

Equally important is Warsaw's strong commitment to green spaces and sustainability. Nearly 40% of the city's area is covered by parks, gardens and green zones, including iconic places such as Łazienki Royal Park, the Vistula boulevards and rooftop gardens like the University of Warsaw Library (BUW).

Thanks to this balance between urban life and nature, Warsaw is a city to visit all year round, offering different experiences in every season. The post-tour programme for InteleTravel participants is organised by the Warsaw Tourism Organisation and is designed to showcase the city as a modern, welcoming and versatile destination for both leisure and MICE markets.
