Gdansk is a historic port city on the Baltic Sea, where centuries of maritime heritage meet contemporary culture and a vibrant urban atmosphere. Shaped by international trade, craftsmanship and openness to the world, the city offers a unique blend of history, architecture and coastal landscapes that invite exploration and discovery.

The city's rich past is reflected in its beautifully preserved Old Town, iconic waterfront, and landmarks connected with amber, shipbuilding and the Solidarity movement – symbols that place Gdansk firmly on the cultural map of Europe. The experience is complemented by a visit to nearby Sopot, Poland's most famous seaside resort, known for its elegant spa traditions, iconic wooden pier and relaxed coastal charm, adding a distinctly leisure-oriented dimension to the programme.

Cuisine plays an important role in the Gdansk experience, drawing on regional traditions and local ingredients, while modern interpretations showcase the city's creative and evolving character.

The post-tour programme is organised by the Gdansk Convention Bureau and offers a carefully curated journey through Gdansk and the nearby seaside resort of Sopot, combining guided sightseeing, cultural experiences and local flavours, providing a relaxed and inspiring conclusion to the main programme.
