1. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to regulate the conditions that should be fulfilled by any automotive lift truck and/or mobile elevating work platform (MEWP), hereinafter the "machines", to be used in the Feria de Madrid in order to guarantee the safety of the people and facilities in the assembly and disassembly phases, and while any event is being held.

2. Responsible declaration

By presenting this Application for Access THE APPLICANT HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING DECLARATION OF RESPONSIBILITY:

1. The company is aware of and accepts the technical regulations of IFEMA for the use of lift trucks and elevating platforms within the exhibition premises as reflected in this document, and also the applicable legal regulations.
2. The people for whom access is requested are aware of said regulations and have been suitably and sufficiently trained to work under said regulations.
3. The machines for which access to the premises is requested fulfil current legal regulations and the IFEMA MADRID rules concerning the use of lift trucks and elevator platforms.

3. General conditions

Exhibitors and/or assembly companies, hereinafter the “companies”, can use the machines in accordance with the conditions and requirements reflected in this document.

- 1.** All machines should have the CE Mark (Royal Decree 1644/2008).
- 2.** All machines should be insured for civil liability, whether the policy is for the machine itself or for the company, in which the serial number of the machine should be specified.
- 3.** Current regulations for the use of automotive lift trucks and elevating platforms should be respected. It is compulsory to fulfil these regulations. In case of non-fulfilment, authorization for access may be withdrawn and/or the corresponding penalty may be applied.
- 4.** Machines shall be parked in areas defined by IFEMA MADRID for this purpose and during the periods of time approved; they may not be parked anywhere else on the premises or outside said periods.
- 5.** Any machine parked outside the areas established for this purpose and/or outside the periods authorized shall be removed and a deterrent fee shall be applied, whose only purpose is to achieve compliance with the regulations and respect for the period authorized.
- 6.** The current parking fees are displayed at the accesses to the premises, accesses to car parks and at automatic and manual pay points. The machine cannot leave the premises until the penalty has been paid.
- 7.** Under no circumstances can any kind of machine be parked in transit areas or evacuation routes or in places that imply a risk for people present in the exhibition ground. A plan of the parking area is at the end of this document.
- 8.** In periods of assembly and disassembly, it will be free to park machines in the areas established by the IFEMA MADRID.
- 9.** In the periods when exhibitions, fairs and other events are being held, companies that wish to park their machines on the premises, within the established areas, shall pay parking fees at the current rates.
- 10.** Only workers who are duly trained and authorized by their company can drive the machines. Companies shall draw up a list of workers authorized to use their machines. This list shall be reflected in the request for access.
The people in charge of the machine should be locatable, via mobile telephone, at all times while the machine is in the exhibition ground.
Machines can only be driven by people who are authorized to do so on the list.
- 11.** All machines should have an Exhibition Grounds Access Sticker. The sticker should contain the following information:
 - Access request number
 - Serial number of the machine
 - Exhibition / Event
- 12.** It is absolutely forbidden to carry out maintenance on the machines within the exhibition grounds, including the parking area defined by IFEMA MADRID.
- 13.** If the company needs to fill its machines up with fuel, they shall do so in accordance With the manual of use of the machine.
- 14.** It is absolutely forbidden to extend the boom of the elevating platform or the load of a lift truck over transit zones. All movements of the machines should be guided from the ground by company personnel, to avoid placing people in the work area at risk.
- 15.** Conditions of safety should be guaranteed in the work zone in accordance with current regulations.
- 16.** In the case of diesel machines the company shall guarantee the correct combustion of the machinery and undertakes to adopt all necessary measures to guarantee the quality of the air in the places where the machines are operating. The company shall take measurements of gases should IFEMA MADRID so require, if they suspect that the activity is emitting gases that could be harmful for people present in the exhibition ground.

4. Authorization procedure

1. Companies that wish to use lift trucks and elevating platforms should fill in the **request for access of lift trucks and elevator platforms** and send it, **signed by the company representative** by e-mail to **stecnica@ifema.es** for approval. The request should include the following data:
 - Access request number.
 - Serial numbers of machines for which access is being requested.
 - The company the machines belong to and contact details.
 - The person responsible for the machines and his/her mobile phone number.
 - Period of validity for the accreditation.
 - List of workers authorized to use the machines, whose training in the handling of the machinery is guaranteed by the company.
2. The company shall present the request at least 30 days before assembly starts; after this deadline requests might not be accepted or authorized. IFEMA MADRID will answer within 7 days of receiving the request.
 - Request approved. The company may access the premises with the machines included in the request.
 - Request refused. IFEMA MADRID will inform of the reasons for not authorizing the request, in such a way that the company can remedy the mistakes or lack of data and present the request again.
3. Once the request has been authorized, the person responsible for the machine should come to the Exhibitor Service Office (located between halls 6 and 8) with the approved access request. He/she will then be given the sticker, which should be placed on the machine in a visible place, and he/she may then access the premises with the machine on the dates assigned. The company should have the machine documentation available at all times for IFEMA MADRID.
4. Any changes to the access request shall be sent by e-mail to **stecnica@ifema.es** or delivered personally at the Exhibitor Service Office (located between halls 6 and 8).
5. If during the use of a machine a malfunction is discovered, or it is seen that the authorized personnel do not have the necessary skills for operating the machine, IFEMA MADRID shall be entitled to cancel the machine access authorization, and the machine will have to be immediately withdrawn from the premises.

5. Documentation for lift trucks and elevator platforms

Following is a list of the documentation the company is responsible for possessing when the access request for lift trucks and elevator platforms is signed, so that it can be authorized:

- Instruction manual for the machine, CE Mark and Technical Characteristics Card or Plaque. This should include the machine's serial number.
- Machine Maintenance Logbook, including services carried out.
- Civil Responsibility Insurance Policy, whether for the machine or for the company that owns it, provided that the machine's serial number is specified therein.
- Receipt of the latest payment of the Civil Responsibility Insurance Policy, showing that the policy is in force.

The IFEMA MADRID may require the company to show this documentation at any time, in order to check that it exists and is correct.

7. Final dispositions

First. The Technical Regulations are compulsory for both exhibitors and for the companies they hire or subcontract, and for any collaborating company which, as a result of the holding of the exhibition, perform work or services for the exhibitor. Consequently, the exhibitor undertakes to inform said hired or subcontracted companies of the participation, regulations to the extent that the tasks entrusted to them to carry out on the exhibition ground premises may be affected.

Second. For cases not included in these regulations, the pertinent regulatory dispositions for the activity shall be applicable.

Third. The legal dispositions cited in these regulations are those in force at the time when this version of the regulations was drawn up. Should any of said dispositions be subsequently amended, the legal reference shall be understood in any case to be to the legislation in force at the time of application.
