Preparing your Presentation

Presenters have been allocated 25 minutes each to give their presentations + 5 minutes Q&A

The structure of a good presentation is as follows:

- •Define the subject, give a general outline and state the goals of your presentation in the introduction
- •Show the details of your work
- •Summarise the findings/conclusion

Please remember the findings/conclusions are often the most important part, leave time to get through these slides without rushing.

EAGE will provide a conference laptop with Microsoft Office to run PPT presentations. A laser pointer and clip microphone will also be provided. If you wish to run a movie please notify us via email as we will need to test it works prior to your session.

Preparing your Presentation

- 1. Please provide your presentation on a USB key or send it to acs@eage.org
- 2. Your presentation can be uploaded during the coffee break/lunch preceding your session.
- 3. On Wednesday 13th November, on the early registration, we will receive usb presentations.
- 4. All presentations are deleted from the laptop at the end of each day. We ensure the recycle bin is also emptied.

Slides – Do's & Don'ts

It is acceptable to use your company template for the PowerPoint slides provided that the logo is discreet but preferable use the EAGE template we sent with this ppt.
Your presentation should not be commercial or a sales pitch in any way.
Check that all animation sequences are working correctly.
Run through the presentation to check you are within the 25 minute limit.

Slides – Do's & Don'ts

X Think about the colours you will use in the presentation – yellow cannot be seen on a white background

X Don't place too many small images onto the same slide. Some people may be seated 30m back from the screen and will not be able to see them.

X Please limit the number of slides

X If you wish to read from notes please have these beside you on the podium in case we are unable to use 'presenter view' with the venue's systems.
