



Dr Patricia Njuguna is the evaluation lead on the Malaria Vaccine Implementation Programme (MVIP) seated within the Global Malaria Programme (GMP), at World Health Organisation (WHO). She has previously been the Head of the Clinical Research Scientific Department and the Head of Clinical Trials at the KEMRI Wellcome Trust Research Programme in Kilifi, Kenya.
