Terms and conditions of registration

Payment Terms

Payment terms are strictly 30 days net from date of invoice. Invoices not paid within 30 day net will incur an 8.5% charge. If booking within 30 days of the event payment must be received 3 weeks prior to the event start date. If within this 3-week timescale, payment must be made at time of registration.

Invoice requests

It is your responsibility to make sure that your finance department processes the invoice in time. Registrations requesting payment by invoice will only be processed if a purchase order is entered on the payment request page. Payment must be received within 30 days of invoice issue date.

Cancellations

Notice of cancellation should be made in writing to <u>events@fitwise.co.uk</u>. Cancellations received by **16th July 2025** will receive a refund minus 20% for administration costs. Unfortunately for cancellations received after this date there will be no refund and if payment has not been received delegates will still be liable for the full delegate fee, this will also apply to delegates registered after **16th July 2025**. Substitute delegates are welcome.

It is your responsibility to ensure you have the appropriate insurance in place to cover your registration costs should you be required to cancel for any reason, including medical, bereavement or travel disruption.
