- On one side of A4Font: Arial, size: 12
- Maximum word count: 500
- The submission should adhere to the subheading structure:
 - o Introduction and demonstration of the importance of this topic
 - o Background including any relevant evidence/guidelines/etc
 - o Relevance to patient care
 - Project details and outcomes (if applicable)
 - Conclusion and any areas for further development
- Up to 2 tables or figures can be included in addition to the one page submission.
- The submission must be on a chosen aspect of continence that demonstrates improving practice and/or sharing knowledge.
