Mira Gleisberg | CEO and Co-Founder of RespiQ - Winner Entrepreneurship

What is your ambition with RespiQ, what is the problem you want to solve with your start-up company?

With our adaptable platform, we envision addressing a myriad of conditions beyond COPD, from asthma to cancer, ushering in a new era of personalized, non-invasive healthcare. "What advice would you give to future female

"My advice to future female leaders will be to be authentic above all. Every one of us has different strengths, and to lead with our genuine strengths is very powerful. Next to this, I would like to encourage women leaders to seek opportunities for growth and give them a chance. For personal development, it is key to have a growth mindset where it is OK to make mistakes as long as we learn from them (brilliant failures). Next to this, in my career, I learned that even though women can create great value, not everyone around you notice what we are bringing to the table. So, I encourage all women to voice out the wonderful things they are



Sophie Bots | Assistant Professor at Utrecht University - Winner Science

What is your long-term ambition with your research, what would you hope to achieve?

"My long-term ambition is to methodologically advance the field of pharmaco-epidemiology so that we can make better use of existing healthcare data sources. I think that these data sources. which contain data collected as part of standard healthcare procedures, are a good reflection of daily medical practice and thus can teach us a lot about for example medication effectiveness and safety in diverse patient populations. This is especially relevant for patient populations often underrepresented in clinical trials, like women, the elderly, patients with many comorbidities, or other marginalised groups. However, analysing these data can be tricky, because you as a researcher were not involved in the process of collecting the information, and so the quality or type of information collected may be different from your ideal scenario. Robust research methods can act as a key to move past these obstacles and unlock the full potential of existing data sources. I want to provide researchers
