## Instructions for stand construction and floor use Expo Hall

### Height Expo Hall varies

The height of the Expo Hall varies by location. Assign therefore clearly where your stand will be placed and keep the maximum height in mind.

### Keep aisles free

Please keep a minimum of 2 meters per aisle. Cross-aisles are prohibited. In addition, we ask you to limit your activities to your stand and thus displays and products within your stand.

### Electro technical facilities

Electro technical facilities come from the pillars. Please note the connections within your stand space and the locations of the connectors on the walls, ceiling and / or columns. The organization can inform you about where technical facilities are present in the hall. Electrical connections must not be covered and connections up to and including 3 kWh should not be looped on the instructions of the Fire Department of Utrecht.

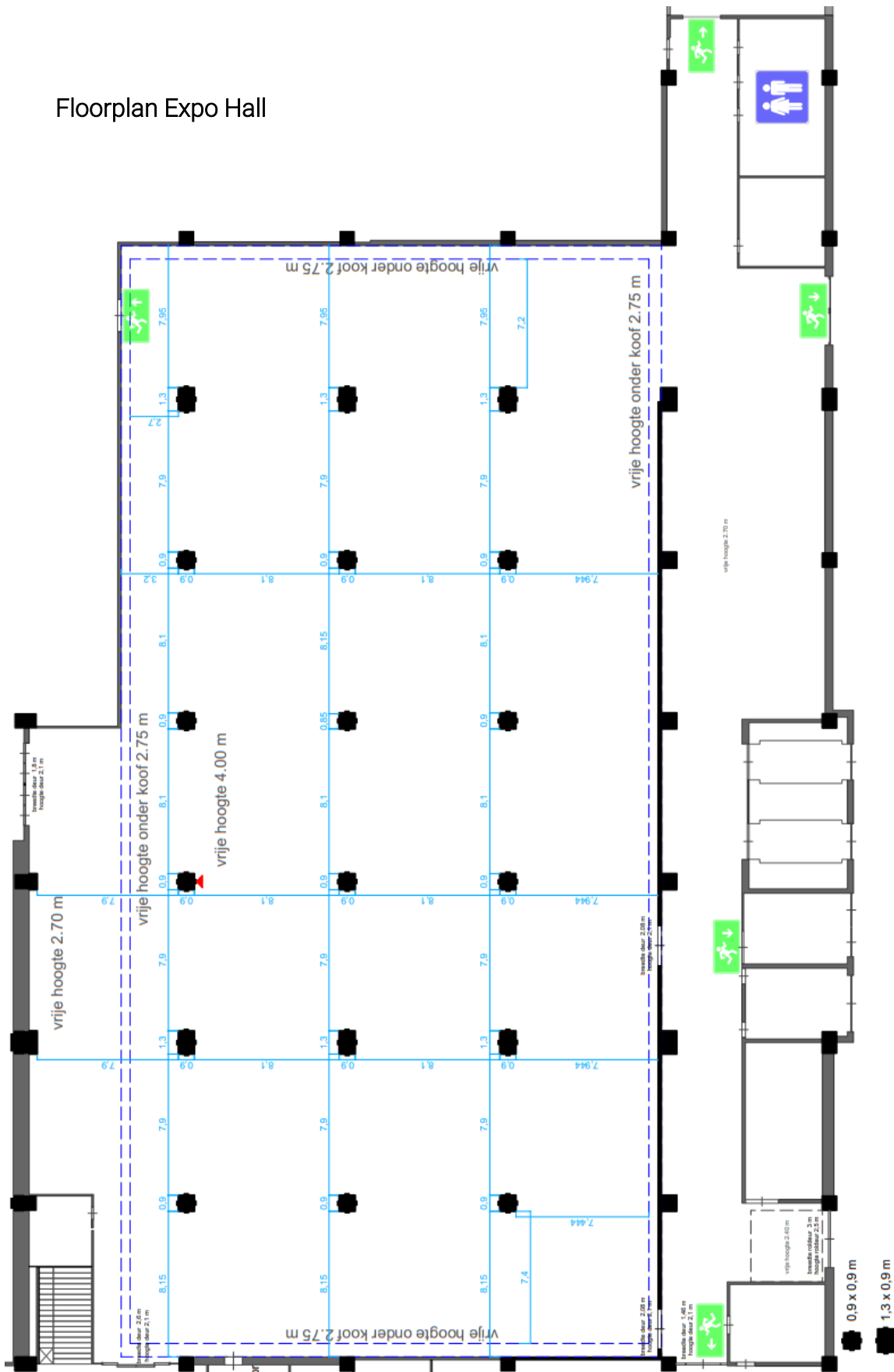
### Usage of floor

Given the size, colour, and the vulnerability of the floor in the Expo Hall a number of precautions need to be followed by:

- No sharp objects are allowed to be placed under the stands (screws, nails, etc.).
- Consider coarse splinters under the walls with timber stands.
- Where necessary, use a protective layer of your stand to prevent damages.
- When painting, a protective layer below the stand is required.
- Neither stand constructions nor furniture may be attached to the floor.
- Use removable tape to the floor, for the purpose of attaching the carpeting. Any damage or additional cleaning of residual adhesive and adhesive residues are calculated.
- Please avoid loose waste when entering the Expo Hall with a pallet truck. The floor will get damaged once waste lies underneath the wheels. Once noticed, remove loose building material whatsoever immediately.
- It is not permitted at any time for posters, paper, etc. to be attached on doors, walls, columns, counters or whatsoever. This is to prevent damage.
- Any damage caused during the rental period, if not caused by Jaarbeurs, will be restored at the expense of the concerning organization.

### Delivering large materials

For the purpose of delivering large booth materials in the Expo Hall, you can check in at the side door to the Mineurslaan, at door 503. The Mineurslaan is a side street of the Croeselaan right of the Beatrix building. Here you can load and unload. We ask you to keep the entrance clear for money transportation etc.

You have up to 30 minutes to load / unload in order to offer other guests also ample space. After loading/ unloading you can park your car at one of the car parks, Parking Croeselaan is the closest.

### Delivering small materials

If you have only small stand materials you can instantly park on P2 or P4 of Jaarbeurs or Parking Croeselaan.
