

Terms and Conditions

Payment of Registration Fees

Full payment must be made by credit/debit card at the time of registration. Visa, Visa Debit, and MasterCard (with 3D Authentication) are accepted. Unfortunately, we cannot accept American Express, Maestro, PayPal or purchasing cards.

Invoice Registration or Registration by PO

Full payment for registration must be made within 14 days of the date on the invoice. All invoices must include the billing address of the organisation or individual responsible for payment. Registrations that have not been completed and paid by the applicable deadline may be cancelled or, where the registration deadline has passed, amended to the next applicable registration rate.

Standard Cancellation Terms

An administration charge of £40.00 will be made to any participant cancelling before 12th August 2026. **No refunds will be given for cancellations received after 3rd August 2026.** However, if you cannot attend, substitutes are welcome at no additional cost. No Shows will NOT be refunded. All alterations or cancellations to your registration must be made in writing and will be acknowledged by email - ictmc@in-conference.org.uk

By submitting your registration, you agree to the terms of our cancellation policy.

Substitutions

Liability

By no means shall ICTMC 2026 be held liable, either directly or indirectly, for any problematic issue that may occur within the framework of the conference and its organization, not only with respect to the organizers but also with respect to third parties (airline companies, hotels, transportation, taxis, etc.) while in the performance of duties or services even indirectly related to the conference.

This contractual liability exemption clause is equally valid in case of an event of force majeure which leads to the disruption and/or the partial or complete cancellation of the conference programme, for reasons not attributable to ICTMC 2026. An event of force majeure is defined as an unforeseen and exceptional event – be it climatic, environmental, political or socio-economic – and does not imply any limitation.

Furthermore, the delegate also expressly agrees to absolve ICTMC 2026 from any responsibility and liability for travel insurance and related costs or claims. It is solely up to the individual to seek out and purchase or otherwise obtain the necessary insurance with regards to his/her travel, etc. and/or to independently issue a claim against any third party that may be responsible for direct or indirect losses or damages caused to or suffered by the delegate enroute to and from the conference.

Data Protection Act 1998/2003

Validity of Passports and Visa Application

It is your responsibility to ensure that your passport is valid for travel, and we recommend that you check with your local Embassy. Please note that some countries require your passport to be valid for up to 3 months from the date of return.

In the event of your visa being denied, refunds will only be given in line with our cancellation terms.
