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GETTING HERE

Whether travelling by air, sea, rail or road, Northumbria University is easily accessible.

Situated in the north-east of England, Northumbria has two separate campuses. The largest, City Campus, is situated in the centre of Newcastle upon Tyne. Coach Lane Campus is situated in a leafy suburb of the city, 3 miles from City Campus.



Newcastle Central Station

Newcastle-upon-Tyne station, Neville Street, Newcastle-upon-Tyne, Tyne & Wear, NE1 5DL
Northumbria City Campus is approximately 1 mile from Newcastle Central Station, the city's main train station. It is accessible via Metro (Central Station), No.1 Bus, Taxi or a 25-minute walk.

Newcastle International Airport

Newcastle International Airport, Woolsington, Newcastle upon Tyne NE13 8BZ
Northumbria City Campus is approximately 7 miles from Newcastle International Airport. It is accessible via Metro (Airport Station), X78 Bus or a 15-minute Taxi ride.

National Express Station

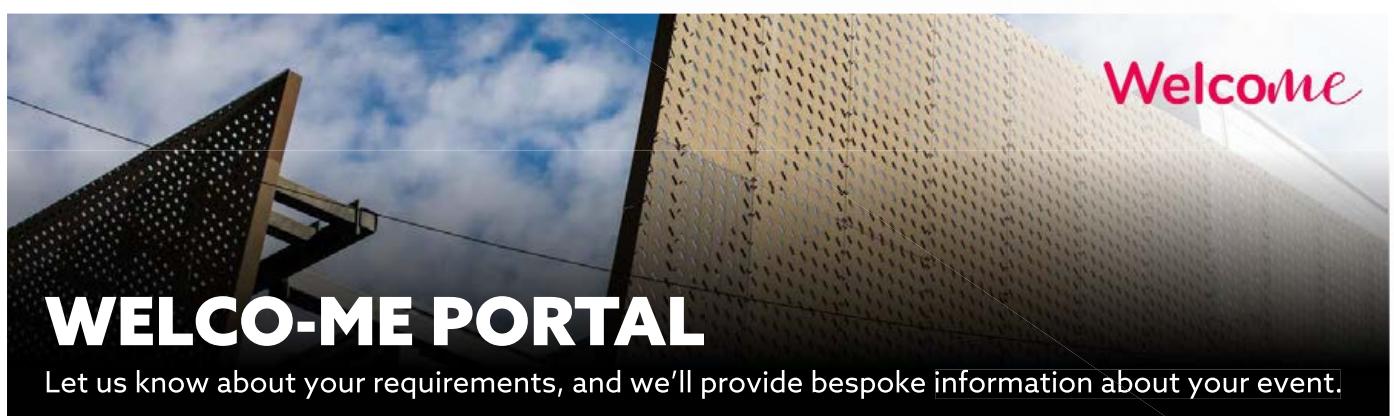
National Express, Newcastle Coach Station, Churchill St, Newcastle upon Tyne NE1 4EE
Northumbria City Campus is approximately 2 miles from Newcastle Coach Station. It is accessible via Metro (St. James Park Station), No.1 Bus or a 15-minute Taxi ride.

Mega Bus / Flix Bus Station

John Dobson Street, Newcastle upon Tyne NE1 8TW
Northumbria City Campus is approximately 2 miles from the Flix/Stagecoach Bus Station. It is just a 5-minute step-free walk to the City Campus.

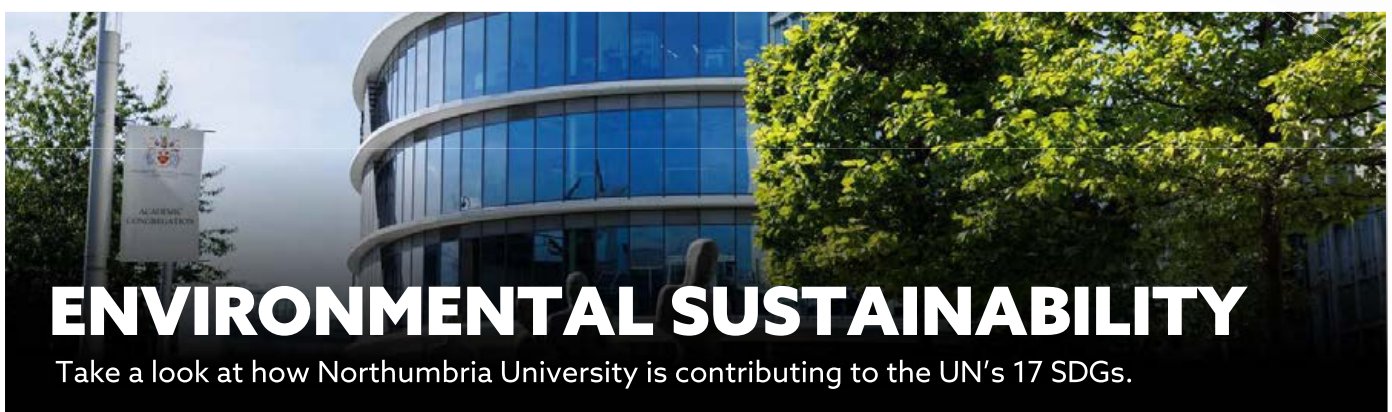
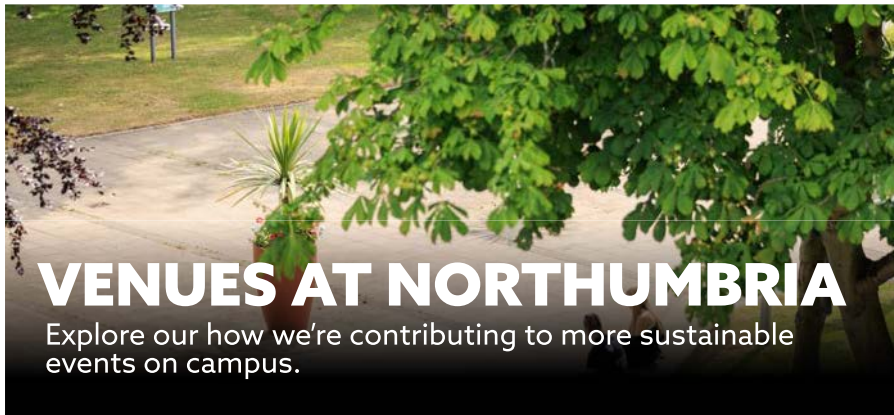

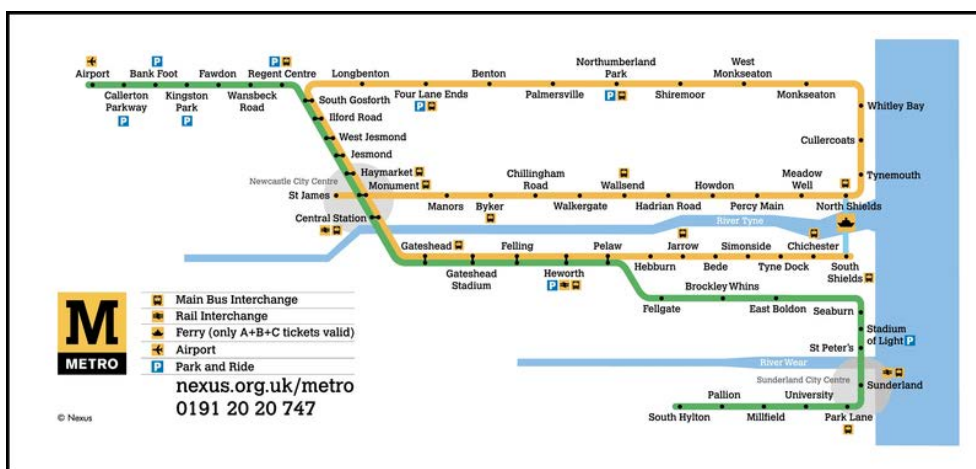
INTER-CITY TRAVEL

It has one of the best integrated transport systems in the country, centred upon the Metro system and the extensive bus networks.

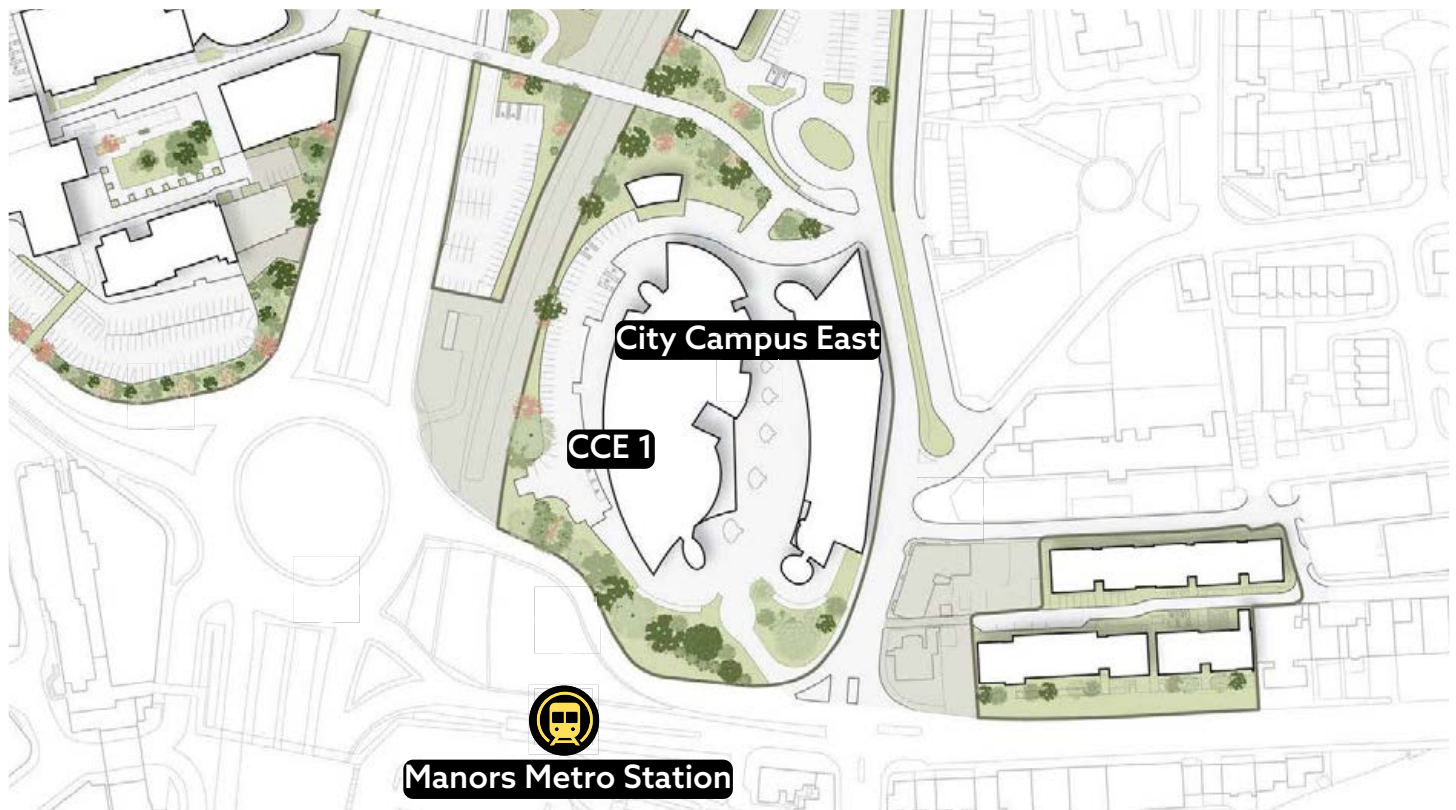
The closest Metro Station to City Campus East is Manors Metro Station. Its just a 5-minute walk from the venue.

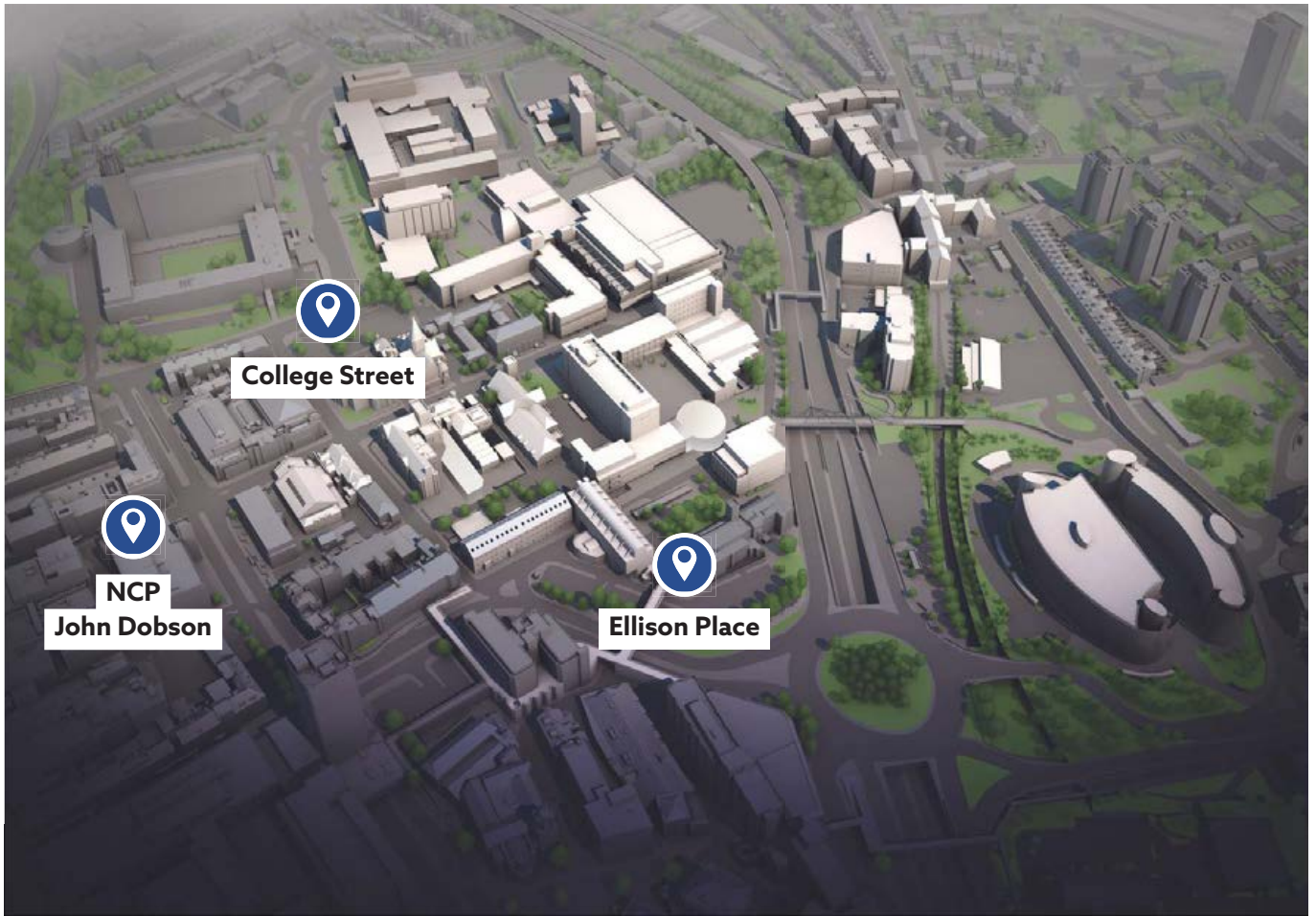


A map of Metro stops can be found [here](#). The closest stops to the venue would be Manors, Haymarket or Monument.

PAY & DISPLAY PARKING



Newcastle John Dobson Street NCP Car Park:

John Dobson St, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8HL

The car park is open 05:30 until 23:30. It is located a 10-minute walk from the venue entrance and has 552 spaces.

College Street Car Park Newcastle City Council:

College Street, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8JG

This car park is open 08:00 until 18:00. It is located a 10-minute walk from the venue and has 73 parking spaces.

Ellison Car Park, Newcastle City Council:

Ellison Place, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8ST

This car park is open 08:00 until 18:00. It is located a 7-minute walk from the venue and has 119 parking spaces.

Eduroam

Visitors to Northumbria can log on to our WiFi network using the username and password from their home university or college, as long as their institution is an Eduroam member. Visitors should check out how to connect to Eduroam at their home university/college before arriving at Northumbria.

SAFETY ON CAMPUS

Make yourself familiar with all alternative exit routes.

If you discover a fire or in the event of hearing the fire alarm/seeing the fire alarm lights activate:

- Raise the alarm by breaking the glass on the nearest red emergency fire call point
- Alert others in your immediate area
- Telephone Security on 0191 227 3200 or ext. 3200 and give exact details of fire. i.e. location, extent of the fire, persons still in building, e.g mobility impaired.
- Evacuate the building immediately, via the nearest safe fire exit route to your nearest designated fire assembly point as shown on the displayed local Fire Instruction Notices and Plan
- Assist others to evacuate if safe to do so
- DO NOT collect personal items or delay your exit.
- DO NOT use lifts.
- DO close all doors after you.
- If you are unable to evacuate due to mobility issues (follow your PEEP), proceed to your nearest Refuge Point:
 - DO inform a member of staff, fire marshal or fellow student of your location.
 - Use the 'Refuge Call Point and/or Vocall Phone. This will alert Security to come and get you
 - A fire evacuation lift or chair will be used by staff to evacuate you from the building
- ONLY tackle to extinguish a fire if you are trained and it is safe to do so.
- DO NOT re-enter the building unless instructed to do so by a member of Security staff
- If you require further assistance for illness or injury, urgent medical help or emergency assistance alert a member of security or call 0191 227 3200 or ext. 3200

It is in your own interests of health and safety to familiarise yourself with emergency procedures for all University buildings. Make yourself familiar with all alternative exit routes. Plans are prominently and clearly displayed on each floor level within all University Buildings.
