Health & Safety Information for Visitors

Welcome to Oxford Instruments

Whilst visiting this site, please observe the following:

Health and Safety at Work: A safe working environment is provided and visitors are requested to co-operate by ensuring we maintain our high safety standards.

Entry into Areas: You must not enter any area of the site unless accompanied by your host.

There are areas within the site where magnetic fields are present. Magnetic fields can affect medical implants, e.g. Heart pace makers, metallic implants and other similar artificial aids. They may also affect watches, credit and bankcards, tapes and discs. Please advise your host if you have implants, or are carrying any of these items. OI is not aware of any risks to an expectant mother or her unborn child from magnet fields. However, as precaution pregnant mothers should be aware there are strong magnetic fields in the workshop areas of the site and are advised not to enter areas where magnets are “at field”. Warning signs are displayed on site where magnetic fields are present.

Emergency procedure: In emergencies an alarm siren will sound. **Immediately leave the premises, following the emergency exit signs to the central pathway located outside the main reception area.** Do not attempt to re-enter the premises for any reason after the siren has sounded. You will be advised when re-entry is permissible. Should you require assistance please inform the Receptionist on your arrival at site.

Protective Equipment: Visitors must observe the area safety instruction at all times. In some areas protective equipment is mandatory. All visitors must wear safety shoes if they enter a designated zone.

Parking: Vehicles must be parked in the designated visitor car parking spaces.

Cameras/Image Capture Devices: Are not allowed without the prior approval of your host

Permit to Work: Contractors will not be allowed to start work until the correct Permit to Work is issued by Facilities.

Non-Smoking: Oxford Instruments operates a no smoking policy.
