Long walk or short walk

To get started, head down towards the end of the Hotel (new wing car park / recycling area) once there, turn onto the walkway "Hilltop Walk".

Follow the single track pathway up to the view point and you will discover a bench perfectly situated to allow you to relax and oversee our spectacular view.

For a longer walk, follow the roped area until you get to the split in the path then bear right and over the stile onto the public footpath of Cadbury Hill.

Please note Cadbury Hill is a public area and is not signposted or marked out but either path you take will eventually lead you out to Cadbury House main road again.

Hilltop walk comprises of a 0.46Km (0.2 mile) walk, it raises to a height of 26 meters at the viewpoint from your start level.

There are several steep rock faces so do not venture too close to the edge. Responsibly supervise any children accompanying you on the walk.

There is 220m of roped walkway, the rope is there merely as a directional guide and not as a security feature or restraint.

Please do not light any fires anywhere on the walk or viewpoint area and remain on the designated walkways.

Cadbury Hill does sometimes have grazing cows so please be aware of this before you venture onto the public side of the fence.

What could you see on the walk?

Several deer have been sighted on the hill in the past, most likely time to come across them is late evening or very early morning.

There are 6 bat boxes that have been located at various points both on Hilltop walk and on Cadbury Hill, these are likely only to be seen at dusk.

There are a multitude of butterfly, bugs and birds. There is also wide variety of tree life including Oak, Yew, Ash and Redwood.

Enjoy the plentiful variety of shrubs, ferns, wild flowers, ivy and holly.
