



Travelling to the Pollock Estate

Located in the vibrant Southside of Edinburgh and nestled on the edge of Holyrood Park - a city space unlike any other with dramatic hills and crags shaping Edinburgh's iconic skyline.

By Car

Cars Parking and Electric Charging Stations

Complimentary car parking is available on the Pollock Estate on a first-come, first-served basis. Spaces are limited, and availability is not guaranteed. Guests must obtain a permit from the main Pollock Halls reception and display it at all times while using the car park.

Electric car charging bays are subject to availability and are provided by Charge Place Scotland. For further information visit their website [Charge Place Scotland](#).

Please be aware that from 1st June 2024 Edinburgh operates a Low Emission Zone (LEZ) to improve air quality in the city centre. This zone covers much of the city centre.

By Bus

Frequent buses from Princes Street to the Pollok Estate include numbers 14, 30 & 33. A single fare is currently £2.40, a day ticket is £6.00. You can pay by contactless card payment or with exact change.

By train

Edinburgh Waverley is the main railway station in Edinburgh. It is a 30-minute walk or 17-minute taxi transfer to the Pollock Estate. The cost is approximately £20.

Taxi Rank

There is a taxi rank outside the Pollock Halls main reception and there is a taxi free phone inside the reception

By Air

Edinburgh Airport is Scotland's busiest airport and is situated 8 miles from the city centre.

A. Taxi from airport

From the airport, it will take approximately 30 minutes to transfer to the Pollock Estate (depending on the time of day). The cost is approximately £35-40.

B. Bus from airport

There are frequent services of the Airlink Service 100 (every 10 minutes) to Waverley Bridge in the city centre. The journey takes about 30 mins. An adult single fare is currently £4.50, and an open return fare is £7.50. You can find out more details on the [Edinburgh Airport transport page](#).

C. Tram from airport

Trams offer a frequent service linking the airport and the city centre (every 8-12 mins). The average journey time from the airport to the city centre is 30 minutes.
