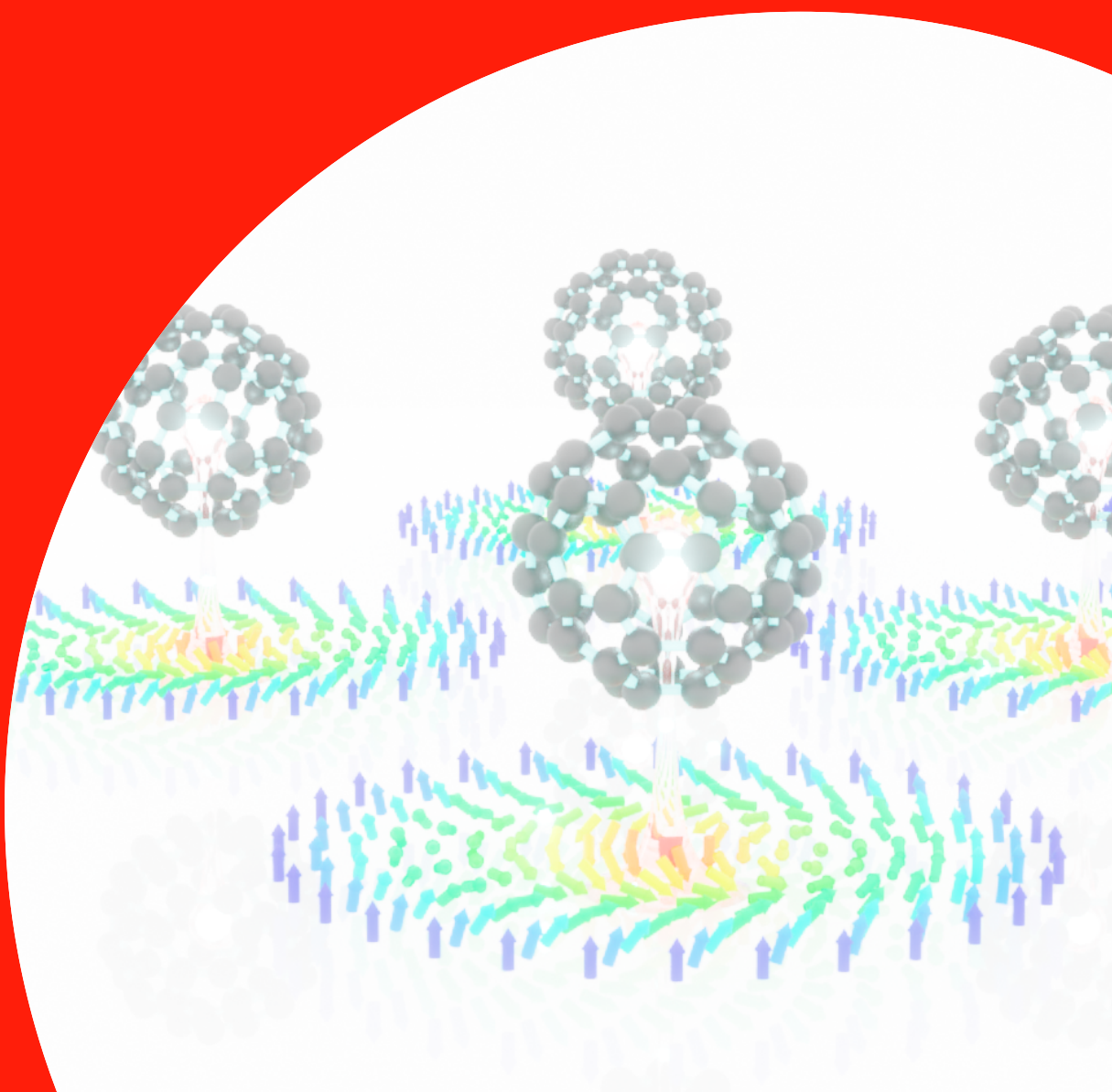

Magnetism 2025 is the premier conference organised by the UK and RoI magnetism community. - Employers of science graduates working in magnetism or related field.

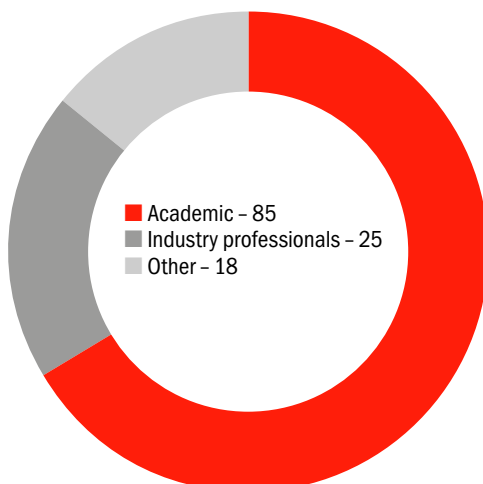

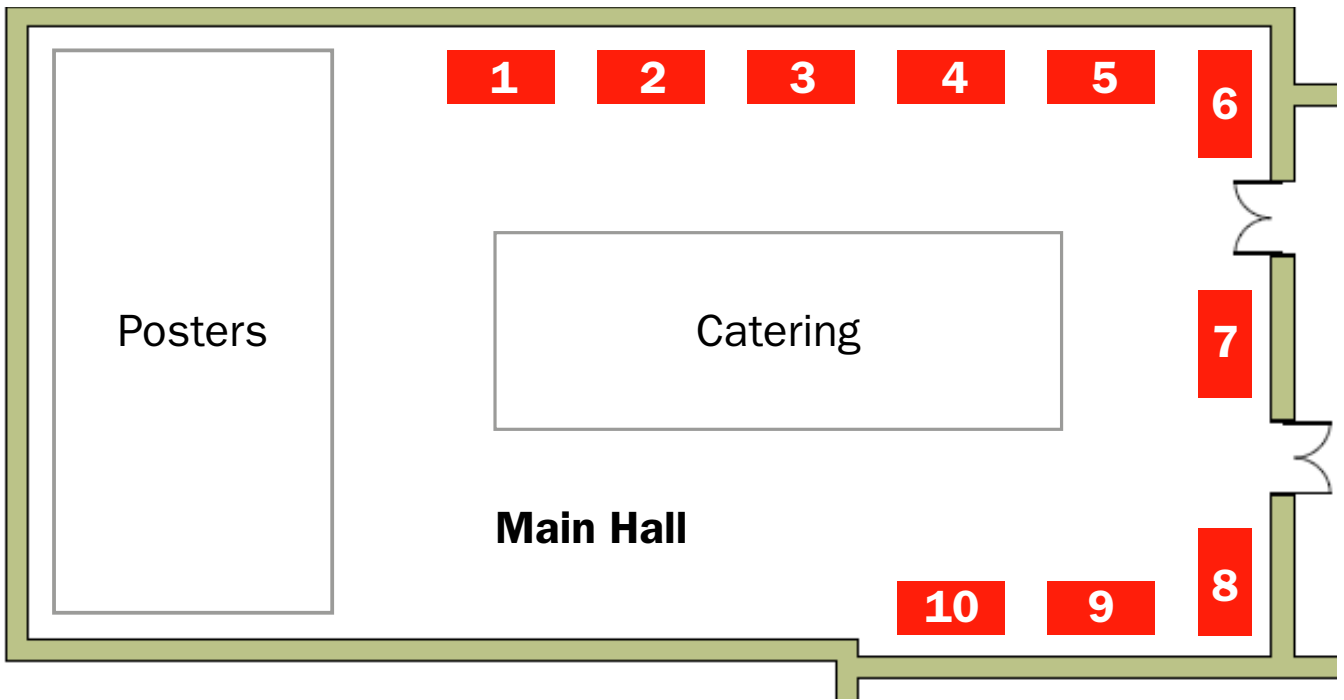

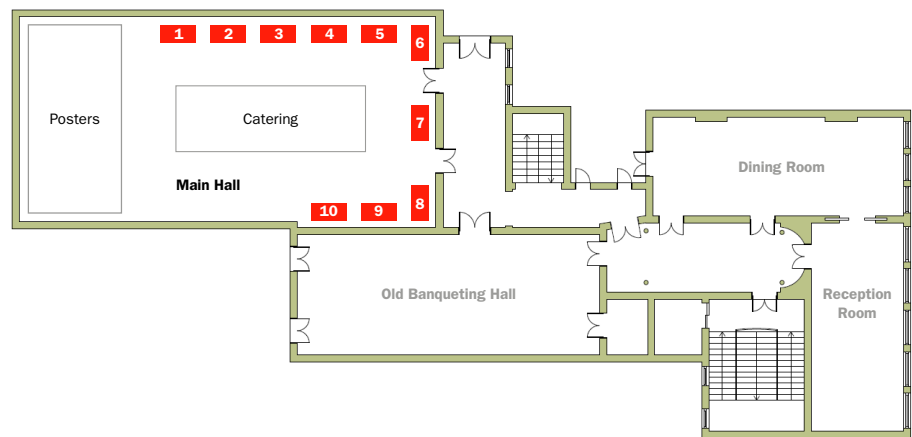
