How to Get Here



You'll find us just two miles north of Leicester City Centre.

Follow the brown rocket signs from all arterial routes (signposted from the M1).

Directions

BY CAR

The National Space Centre is located just off the A6, two miles north of Leicester City Centre, midway between Leicester's inner and outer ring roads.

Brown road signs with a distinctive rocket logo will direct you from the arterial routes around Leicester.

We have over 400 parking spaces in our car park, including 23 enhanced accessibility spaces.

BY BUS

First Bus 54 runs every 10 mins throughout the day Monday to Saturday and every 20 mins on Sunday running from 9.30am.

The bus stop is only 6 minutes' walk away from the National Space Centre

BY RAIL

East Midland Trains and Cross Country Trains serve Leicester Station. From here you can either take a bus or a taxi to the National Space Centre.

First bus 54 runs every 10 minutes Monday to Saturday and every 20 minutes on Sunday from Charles Street, a short walk from the station

Please consider **sustainable transportation** - As part of our commitment to reducing our event carbon footprint, we ask that organisers encourage their delegates to use sustainable transportation.

Here are some examples of sustainable transportation options for your event:

Public Transportation: Encourage event attendees to utilise public transportation such as buses or train. The National Space Centre is easily accessible by public transport which is detailed above.

Cycling and Walking: We have bike racks and pedestrian-friendly routes to facilitate this option.

Carpooling: Encourage attendees to carpool or use ridesharing services like Uber, this can significantly reduce the number of vehicles on the road.

Electric Vehicles (EVs): We have four electric vehicle charging points five minutes' walk to the main entrance.

Shuttle Services: If possible, arrange shuttle services using low-emission vehicles or even electric buses.

Virtual or Hybrid Events: The National Space Centre has state of the art hybrid facilities to allow delegates to opt for virtual or hybrid formats and eliminate the need for transportation of guests travelling from longer distances, including international attendees which would significantly reduce the environmental impact associated with travel.
