I. Data Controller

II. Purpose of Data Processing

Your personal data will be collected and used for the following purposes:

- To manage the submission, review, and selection of abstracts.
- To communicate with you regarding your submission and related conference activities.
- To prepare the scientific program, including publication of accepted abstracts in conference materials (digital or printed).
- To process your participant registration, including invoicing, badge creation, and access to conference sessions and events.
- To organize catering and accommodation services related to your participation (including dietary requirement information where applicable).
- To comply with administrative, financial, and legal obligations.

III. Categories of Data Collected

We may collect the following information:

- Name, institutional affiliation, and contact details (email address, telephone number, country).
- Abstract title, text, author information, and co-author details.
- Professional background and role relevant to the submission.
- Registration details (e.g., session attendance, special requirements, ticket type, payment information).
- Dietary, accessibility, and mobility information, where provided.
- Event-related communications and consents (e.g., photography, exhibitor communications).



IV. Legal Basis for Processing

Processing of your personal data for registration and participation is based on your explicit consent under applicable data protection laws. By completing the registration form and proceeding with registration, you consent to the processing of your personal data as described in this notice.

You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting the ISE at events@ise-online.org. Withdrawal will not affect any processing that has already taken place.

V. Data Retention

Your data will be stored securely and retained only as long as necessary for the purposes stated above, typically up to 10 years after the conference.

VI. Data Sharing

ISE may share your data with authorized partners involved in organizing, reviewing, and publishing the conference materials, as well as with service providers (e.g., registration platform, catering, venue, and accommodation providers) strictly for the purposes outlined above. Data will not be sold or shared for unrelated marketing or commercial purposes.

VII. Your Rights

You have the right to access, rectify, or erase your personal data and to object to or restrict its processing. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with your local data protection authority.

VIII. Consent Statement

By submitting your abstract and/or completing the participant registration form, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Data Processing Notice and consent to the processing of your personal data for the purposes described above.
