### I. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions (“Terms”) govern the submission of abstracts and the registration of participants through the International Society of Electrochemistry (ISE) abstract submission and registration platforms (“Portal”). By submitting an abstract and/or completing registration, you (“Submitter” or “Participant”) agree to comply with these Terms. Please read them carefully before proceeding.

### II. Eligibility

- Abstract submissions are open to researchers, professionals, and students working in electrochemistry or related scientific fields.
- Registration is open to all eligible participants in accordance with the event’s registration categories and requirements.
- Submitters and participants must ensure that they have the right to present and publish the work described in the abstract, where applicable.

### III. Submission & Registration Guidelines

- Only registrations completed through the official ISE registration Portal will be valid.
- Each abstract must comply with the formatting, length, and content guidelines specified on the Portal.
- Registration must be completed before the applicable registration deadline. Late, incomplete, or unpaid registrations may not be accepted or may be cancelled.
- Abstracts must be submitted before the official submission deadline. Late or incomplete submissions will not be accepted.
- The submitting author is responsible for ensuring that all listed co-authors have approved the abstract content prior to submission.
- The participant is responsible for ensuring that all registration information provided is complete and accurate.



## IV. Review and Selection Process

- All abstracts will undergo a review and selection process by the ISE Executive Committee and/or designated reviewers.
- Acceptance or rejection decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
- The reviewers reserve the right to assign accepted abstracts to oral, poster, or other presentation formats.

## V. Presenter Responsibilities

- The presenting author must register for the meeting by the stated registration deadline.
- Abstracts for which the presenting author has not registered will be withdrawn from the scientific program.
- Presenters are expected to deliver their presentations as scheduled in the final program.
- Registered participants are responsible for attending sessions and events in accordance with the final program and event rules.

## VI. Publication and Copyright

- By submitting an abstract, the author(s) grant ISE a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to publish, reproduce, and disseminate the abstract (in print, electronic form, or online platforms) as part of the conference or symposium materials.
- Submitters retain the copyright to their work.
- Abstracts must not contain any material that infringes upon the intellectual property rights of others.

## VII. Data Protection

- Personal data collected during abstract submission and registration will be processed in accordance with the ISE Data Processing Consent Form and applicable data protection laws, including GDPR where applicable.
- Submitters and participants are encouraged to review the Data Processing Notice before giving consent and completing submission or registration.
- By submitting an abstract and/or registering for the event, you consent to the processing of your personal data for the purposes described in the relevant notice.

## VIII. Accuracy of Information

- The submitter and/or participant is responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information provided, including names, affiliations, contact details, abstract content, and registration details.
- ISE assumes no responsibility for any errors arising from inaccurate or incomplete submissions or registrations.

## IX. Amendments, Withdrawal and Cancellation

- Abstracts may be amended or withdrawn by the submitter up to the submission deadline.



- After the deadline, changes cannot be guaranteed and will only be made at the discretion of ISE.
- Registrations may be amended or cancelled in accordance with the applicable registration and cancellation policy, where provided.
- ISE reserves the right to cancel or modify registrations in cases of non-payment, incomplete information, or breach of these Terms.

## X. Liability Disclaimer

- ISE accepts no responsibility for technical issues, data loss, or internet connectivity problems experienced during the submission or registration process.
- Submitters and participants are encouraged to keep backup copies of their abstract, registration details, and confirmation emails.
- ISE bears no liability for travel, accommodation, or other costs incurred due to abstract acceptance, rejection, registration issues, or withdrawal.

## XI. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms and Conditions are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Switzerland. Any disputes arising under or in connection with these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Lausanne, Switzerland.
