Our guided tour will take you to the lively streets of our capital city of Valletta. Our stops include the Upper Barracca Gardens built atop the defensive bastions surrounding this majestic city. These gardens, built by the Knights of St. John, command breathtaking views of the Grand Harbour and the fortified Three Cities. Next is a visit at St John's Co-Cathedral. A co-Cathedral with a minimalist fort exterior and an interior of finest examples of high Baroque architecture in Europe, including the acclaimed Caravaggio painting that is on display in the Oratory. A visit within the Church Museum which has on display beautiful Flemish tapestries. We then proceed with an interesting walk where we can appreciate the capital's buildings of historical importance including the Grand Master's Palace. Our final stop will be at the famed Malta Experience, a multivision show that gives a pictorial depiction of Malta's history through the ages since the earliest settlements dating back to pre-historic times.

Highly recommended day tour! Malet, Melite, Medina, once the Island's capital city. The narrow meandering streets and mysterious alleyways of the now called Mdina, are shrouded with tales from the Bronze age to date. Great bird's eye view from the bastions with three thirds of Malta beneath. On to Rabat, through the Greek Gate and a walk to the catacombs. Then a drive to the southwest coast of the island to Dingli cliffs. Splendid views of the open sea and the tiny island of Filfla. After a lunch break, we visit the botanic gardens of San Anton, home to some of the island's flora and also of the President of the Republic of Malta. A stop in the Basilica of Mosta is included, known for its impressive dome. Our last stop will be to the crafts centre at Ta` Qali. Local artisan displays of glass blowing, pottery and filigree. Time for shopping is allocated. A complete excursion capturing the central highlights of Malta.

Walk the streets of this medieval town today known as the 'silent city' whilst your guide unravels its rich history from the Bronze Age Period to present Mdina. Walk through the secretive narrow winding streets to discover its dwarfed doorways, till you reach the city's bastions from where a stunning panoramic view of the island can be seen. The tour continues with a visit to the Dingli cliffs, known as the highest cliffs on the island. From here you can look out to the island of Filfla. Our final stop will be to the botanic gardens of San Anton, these originally being walled gardens for a palace which once served as a leisure residence for the Grand Master. A truly relaxing half day excursion in and around the old capital of Malta.

The tour starts with a visit to one of Malta's oldest quarries which has been converted to explain the evolution of limestone. A vivid account of one of Malta's leading skills - the understanding of limestone for building purposes, a skill introduced by Neolithic men. The magic of Malta's birth will be explained at Ħaġar Qim, a pre-historic site, overlooking the blue Mediterranean seas and the islet of Filfla. From here, proceed to Wied iż-Żurrieq where (weather permitting - boat price not included) you can take a boat trip to the Blue Grotto, renowned for its crystal clear waters. After lunch, we drive through rural Malta and local vineyards to the idyllic fishing village of Marsaxlokk. You will have time to stroll through the local market set along the waterfront promenade. Final stop is at Għar Dalam, archaeologist's haven! Ample proof that Malta once formed part of the European landmass.

Step back with us through the mists of time as we take you to the fortress of Cottonera which is widely known as the three cities, these being Vittoriosa, Cospicua and Senglea, built and fortified by the Knights of Malta. Our morning starts with an informative drive through Cospicua followed by a visit to Vittoriosa where we navigate the narrow streets and mysterious alleyways shaded by many historic palaces and churches. Then we proceed to the old quay where we take a harbour cruise on a fregatina, which is a traditional Maltese boat, for a tour of the famous harbour creeks, a truly unique way to view the impressive bastions and fortifications that dominate the port. Finally we drive to Senglea where we share the breathtaking view from the beautiful vedette conveniently situated in the centre of the Grand Harbour.
