

Arrival to Nice Airport

The Nice Airport, officially called **Nice Côte d'Azur Airport** has 2 separate terminals which provide air travel to a large number of national, European and international destinations, with a mix of international and domestic flights handled by each terminal.

Terminal 1 is for international, Schengen, and non-Schengen flights.

Terminal 2 newer and larger and is also for international flights and internal French flights.

A free shuttle-bus provides service between the two terminals and the parking lots. The shuttle-bus runs every 8 minutes during peak hours and every 15 minutes at other times.



【Access to Hotel from Nice Airport】

By Taxi

From Nice Airport, around 40 minutes ride.

Fix-rate fare: 95€ (excluding supplement)

By Bus Line 80

[Bus Line 80](#) runs between Nice Airport & Monaco, and get off at “Larvotte (Hotel Méridien)” stop.

The hotel is in front of the Bus stop.



Bus Line 80 Schedule

Bus Line 80 operates every day, with departures every 60 minutes to-from Monaco. Average journey time is 50 minutes for depending on traffic.

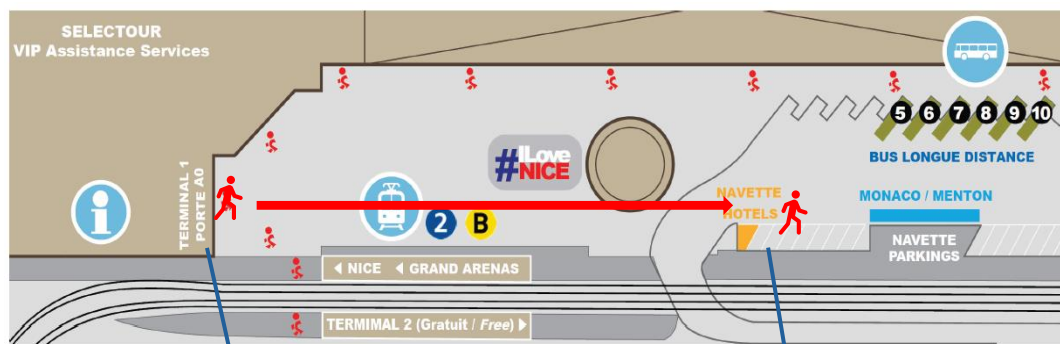

Bus Line 80 (“The Zou!”) boarding points at the airport

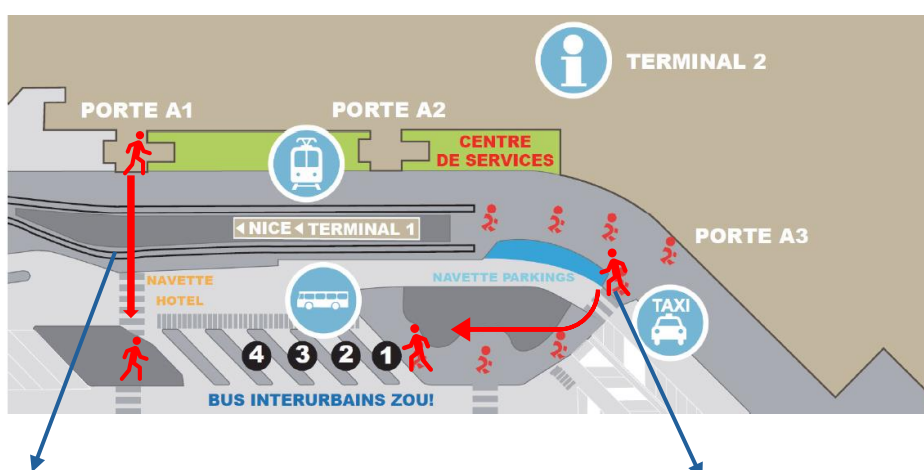
At Terminal 1

Upon arrival, follow the signs for “bus station”, “trams”, and “to Terminal 2”, then exit through gate A0 and follow the sign for “Line 80 Nice/Monaco/Menton”.



At Terminal 2

Upon arrival, please exit through gate A1 or A3 on the arrivals floor. Follow the sign of “Bus”. The bus terminal is on the other side. Line 80 (to Monaco/Menton) usually departs from Dock 1.



*Bus boarding points may change due to construction works or other reasons. Please confirm your destination with the driver upon boarding on the day.
