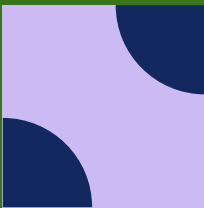
Transportation

Choose trains over flights whenever possible, and offset unavoidable travel emissions. Once in Rotterdam, use public transport, walk, or cycle. If flying is unavoidable, consider direct flights and economy class to reduce your travel footprint.



Accommodation

Go paperless where possible. Use the official conference app and website for schedules, maps, and session information. Avoid printing tickets or documents unless necessary.



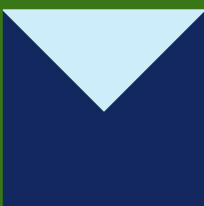
Reduce and Separate Waste

Avoid single-use items and packaging wherever possible, and use the paper and plastic recycling stations throughout the exhibition area. Separate your waste correctly to help reduce the amount of waste generated and support recycling.



Bring Your Bottle

Bring a reusable water bottle to refill at hydration stations throughout the venue. For coffee and meals, the venue provides reusable tableware instead of single-use alternatives. Help us reduce waste by choosing reusable options whenever possible.



Badge and Lanyards

On the last day of the conference, you can return your badge and lanyard at the registration desk. Returned lanyards will be repurposed for future events and badges will be recycled.
