Official Statistics lay the groundwork for informed decisionmaking. They provide transparent, accurate, and reliable data and information for citizens and policymakers with the aim to generate prosperity.


Information on and assessment of:

- Short term goals (e.g. CPI)
- Long term goals (e.g. SDGs)
- Crisis management (e.g. Covid-Mortality)

In the German "Democratic" Republic (GDR), over-achievement of 5 year plans was statistically confirmed on a regular basis

Whereas long queues in front of supermarkets and empty shelves reflected a different reality




Uncertainty paves the ground for fake news and alternative facts



Official Statistics support accurate policy measures


Growing inaccuracy due to ideology-driven policy measures

Direct (Political) Threats

- Sudden replacements of independent heads of NSIs
- Merger of an NSI with a political body or ministry
- Entire dissolution of the NSI

Indirect (Political) Threats

- Insufficient financial resources for NSI
- Defamation of competences in the media (e.g. higher trust in other producers)
- Exclusion from statistically relevant legislation (e.g. digitalization, data)
- Exclusion from new tasks and responsibilities in the data ecosystem




Official statistics need to be a fortress fending off the attacks







Principles and Quality Frameworks create a solid foundation









Lack of independence creates risk of political influence



Lack of Best Practices and Quality create unreliable results




Lack of Transparency creates opportunity for misuse of statistics
