




# Towards a metadata-driven system

Two convergent developments:

- 1. Search for methods to reduce revisions and increas production efficiency
- 2. Launch of a new metadata system the Metadata bank to contain all metadata
- → Metadatadriven production

# The Metadata bank

- A system to contain all metadata
- Built in Colectica and based on GSIM



Initially focus on populating the system


Now: enable metadatadriven production

# The Source data system NA

- System to receive and harmonise input data to the National Accounts
- A transparent validation and classification process
- A wish for a selfdocumenting system with version control
- → A metadatadriven system is the solution

# How the metadata-driven system works

- Continuous and close cooperation between owners and users of data and metadata
- → Delivery and transformation contracts
- A clear division of responsibilities is key



# What we have learned?

The move from metadata storing to metadatadriven production means stronger demands on the Metadata bank

- 1. The Metadata bank has to be ready and available when the production cycle starts
- 2. Focus on internal consistency so several sources can be integrated
- 3. Adequate IT ressources and staff
- 4. Need to reconsider roles and responsibilities
