The Trigger


2019 - Reform of data collection in public administration project

Metadata + Quality + Product driven NSS



 Responding to new challenges posed to both the members of the NSS and the coordinator

Coordination aimed at:

- Quality
- Standardisation and harmonisation of processes
- Quality of products
- Metadata management

Legislation

The last amendment to the **Act on State Statistics** strengthened the position of SOSR as the NSS coordinator

- Coordination Council for State Statistics
- Defined scope of coordination activities
- Specified the competences of other authorities carrying out official statistics
- The Uniform Information System of State Statistics was defined as one of the standardisation and coordination tools


Institutional changes

Central Coordination Unit

- Coordinating and providing methodological guidance to ONAs
- Planning, organising and evaluating methodological audits in accordance with ISO 9001
- Compiling and updating of National Quality Guidelines for NSS
- Monitoring the production, completeness and dissemination of national quality reports for users

Chief Statistician of the NSS

 Creation and development of basic methodological and quality assurance framework for state statistics

- Controversial nominations of some members

Unified information system

- Common tool for NSS
- Standardisation of NSS products and processes
- Source of data regarding coordination

- Not covering all GSBPM phases
- Slow start





- Verify the status of internal documentation of NSS members and compliance with common guidelines
- Review of compliance with the Code of Practice and the obligations related to NSS membership

- Time consuming
- Big differences between NSS members
