

Short-cycle tertiary education courses: Higher education course (Curso Técnico Superior Profissional – CTeSP) of a professional nature that does not confer an academic degree. Includes one semester of internship. Duration: 2 years | 120 ECTS.

Bachelor's or equivalent courses: Higher education course conferring the academic degree (Licenciado). Duration: 3 years | 180 ECTS. Exceptionally in some areas it can be 4 years | 240 ECTS.

METHODOLOGY:

This poster analyzes and present the average of the last 5 years (2017/18 to 2022/23) of student's pursuing studies in higher education – CTeSP and Bachelor's or equivalent degree using information gathered from official higher education statistics (Register of Students, Enrolments and Graduates in Higher Education - RAIDES).
