






231 SDGs indicators are only the tip of the iceberg



The key role of data platforms in monitoring the 2030 Agenda was recognized from the beginning






INE Platform: Specifically developed for SDG but integrated in IT architecture

Objectives:

- Collection of available data
- Dissemination and visualization through a single access point
- Transmission to custody agencies (SDMX files)



INEbase / Goals and targets (from the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development)


The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development consists of 17 goals and 169 targets. In order to monitor its progression, 232 indicators have been designed that can be measured using the statistical data contained herein. These indicators are updated continuously and this action includes information from both the INE and other official sources that are incorporated progressively


Sub-indicator 9.5.2.1. Researchers (in full-time equivalent) per million inhabitants






Sub-indicator 9.5.2.1. Researchers (in full-time equivalent) per million inhabitants







Sub-indicator 9.5.2.1. Researchers (in full-time equivalent) per million inhabitants












Work in progres

- Promoting the use of new data sources (e.g., Earth observations)
- Continuing with the existing collaboration with Autonomous Communities and Local Entities to improve coverage and disaggregation
- Generating files in SDMX format to send to custodian agencies







NRPs as a coordination tool

- Many organizations responsible for producing SDG Indicators (15 ministries and the Bank of Spain)
- Methodological discussions are carried out before deciding the inclusion of data and metadata








Few statistics have greater relevance than SDG indicators

- Resolution of the UN General Assembly
- Open consultations
- Spanish Higher Statistics Council, an advisory body
- Many meetings with ministries and other institutions, including civil society









Accuracy and Reliability

- Input validation to improve quality
- Help identify data gaps








Timeliness and Punctuality

- Allow reporting of statistics on a continuous basis as they become available
- INE Platform incorporates data as soon as the source is available
- When produced by INE, data are automatically incorporated








SDMX can improve cross-domain coherence

- UN actions: IAEG-SDGs working group on SDMX, UNSD SDG Data Lab
- INE is working on SDMX transmission (around 120 series in SDMX format)
- Objective: automated transmission to custodian agencies








Accessibility and Clarity

- Centralizes all SDG indicators into a single-entry point
- Visualization tools (tables, graphs, maps)
- Time series data to analyze the progress towards SDGs
- Download data in various formats
- Enhance transparency providing metadata (Spanish and UN)
- Standardized methodological report (ESS Handbook for Quality and Metadata Reports standards)
