



## Team Welfare Role Description

**Who to contact:** Your first point of contact should be your team leader.

**Area Description:** The Welfare team is at the heart of creating a safe, welcoming, and well-supported festival environment for everyone on site. This area includes stewarding - supporting and directing participants and assisting first responders - alongside qualified medical volunteers, safeguarding leads who ensure best practice is followed, and team welfare volunteers who care for and support the wider volunteer body throughout the event.

**Team Description:** The Team Welfare department is dedicated to the wellbeing of the volunteer team. This includes ensuring that meals are readily available and that everyone stays properly hydrated. While also keeping a watchful eye on team members who may need an extra break or additional support.

**Time Commitment:** Three months building up to WeBelieve 24-27 July 2026. Including a fortnightly 'all-team' video call (weekday evening), ad-hoc 'team meetings', and the festival itself: 10am Friday 24th - midday Monday 27th July.

### **What you will be doing:**

Before the event

- Ensure supplies for the team kitchen have been ordered

At the event

- Manage the stock of food/drink in the team kitchen
- Set up and clear away breakfast in the team kitchen
- Ensure team members receive their daily meal token
- Provide the team members on shift with water throughout the day
- Regularly check in with team members to ensure they are being supported
- Liaise with team leaders to see if meals need to be brought to team members on shift
- Keep the team spaces clean and tidy

### **What you will need:**

- Bags of energy, resilience and patience!
- A positive attitude and cheerful disposition.
- Physical ability for lifting, carrying and being on your feet most of the day.
- The ability to follow clear instructions without deviation.
- To work in a team under the supervision of a Team Leader.
- On site from 10:00AM Friday 24th July to 12:00PM Monday 27th July, 2026.

### **Daily pattern:**

- This team operates between 07:00 and 23:00.
- Shift lengths will vary from 3hrs to 7hrs. You may be required to work a split shift.
- You will have meal breaks and rest periods.
- You will be asked to help with set-up and pack-down.
