Area Description: The Content team helps bring the festival's programme to life, both on stage and behind the scenes. This includes emcees who provide confident front-of-house stage presence, venue managers coordinating smooth back-of-house operations, the prayer team supporting liturgies and other prayer experiences, and the family team ensuring that content for children and families runs smoothly and joyfully.

Team Leader: Iona Robinson

Team Description: The family team oversees the family-focused content across the site, supporting sessions as an extra pair of hands where needed. Their role includes assisting speakers with practical needs such as guiding attendees to the chapel, gathering resources, and being present throughout sessions to ensure everything runs smoothly.

Time Commitment: Three months building up to WeBelieve 24-27 July 2026. Including a fortnightly 'all-team' video call (weekday evening), ad-hoc 'team meetings', and the festival itself: midday Friday 24th - midday Monday 27th July.

What you will be doing:

- Managing the family content
- Attending all the family sessions
- Ensuring resources are supplied for the sessions
- Coordinate the moving of locations for the family content
- Assisting speaker where needed
- Managing the program in the family tent

What you will need:

- Great with kids
- Bags of energy, resilience and patience!
- A positive attitude and cheerful disposition.
- Physical ability for lifting, carrying and being on your feet most of the day.
- The ability to follow clear instructions without deviation.
- To work in a team under the supervision of a Team Leader.
- On site from 10:00AM Friday 24th July to 12:00PM Monday 27th July, 2026.

Daily pattern:

- The team operates between 08:00 and 23:00.
- Shift lengths will vary from 3hrs to 7hrs. You may be required to work a split shift.
- You will have meal breaks and rest periods.
- You will be asked to help with set-up and pack-down.
