



Medical Team Role Description

Who to contact: Your first point of contact should be your team leader.

Area Description: The Welfare team is at the heart of creating a safe, welcoming, and well-supported festival environment for everyone on site. This area includes stewarding - supporting and directing participants and assisting first responders - alongside qualified medical volunteers, safeguarding leads who ensure best practice is followed, and team welfare volunteers who care for and support the wider volunteer body throughout the event.

Team Leader: Sinan

Team Description: The medical team is made up of qualified medics who will take shifts to be on call around the clock throughout the duration of the festival, ensuring that any medical needs are addressed promptly and with care. A designated room within the college will be assigned to the medical team for their use, providing a dedicated space to support their work.

Time Commitment: Three months building up to WeBelieve 24-27 July 2026. Including a fortnightly 'all-team' video call (weekday evening), ad-hoc 'team meetings', and the festival itself: midday Friday 24th - midday Monday 27th July.

What you will be doing:

Before the event

- Gather any medical supplies needed for the festival
- Liaise with the college to see what equipment they have on site
- Ensure the supplies are brought to the site

At the event

- Manage all the medical supplies
- Manage any incidences that involve medical interference
- Triage injuries and medical conditions
- Look out for the team and ensuring physical and mental welfare
- Be on call for set shifts around the clock for the duration of the festival

What you will need:

- Qualification in the medical field
- Bags of energy, resilience and patience!
- A positive attitude and cheerful disposition.
- Physical ability for lifting, carrying and being on your feet most of the day.
- The ability to follow clear instructions without deviation.
- To work in a team under the supervision of a Team Leader.
- Relevant professional experience if applying to join the medical team (made up of nurses and doctors).
- On site from 10:00AM Friday 24th July to 12:00PM Monday 27th July, 2026.

Daily pattern:

- This team operates around the clock



- Shift lengths will vary from 3hrs to 7hrs. You may be required to work a split shift.
- You will have meal breaks and rest periods.
- You will be asked to help with set-up and pack-down.
