



## Stewarding Team Role Description

**Who to contact:** Your first point of contact should be your team leader.

**Area Description:** The Welfare team is at the heart of creating a safe, welcoming, and well-supported festival environment for everyone on site. This area includes stewarding - supporting and directing participants and assisting first responders - alongside qualified medical volunteers, safeguarding leads who ensure best practice is followed, and team welfare volunteers who care for and support the wider volunteer body throughout the event.

**Team Description:** The stewards team is the largest team on site, serving as the eyes and ears across the festival grounds and ready to respond to any situation that may require assistance. As a steward, responsibilities may include managing a venue, overseeing the car park, or patrolling the site. Our stewards play a vital role in ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all attendees.

**Time Commitment:** Three months building up to WeBelieve 24-27 July 2026. Including a fortnightly 'all-team' video call (weekday evening), ad-hoc 'team meetings', and the festival itself: midday Friday 24th - midday Monday 27th July.

### **What you will be doing:**

- Overseeing the safety and smooth running of the festival site
- Be the first point of contact for any safety concern on site
- Manage the festival venues, ensuring they are not overcrowded and exits are kept clear
- Coordinate the organisation of the car parks
- Patrol the site throughout the day to ensure prevent hazards from arising
- Communicate with the control room in case of any disruptions on site
- Wear a hi-vis whenever on shift
- Have a radio on you when applicable
- Know the site's emergency procedures
- In case of an emergency follow the correct procedures

### **What you will need:**

- Bags of energy, resilience and patience!
- A positive attitude and cheerful disposition.
- Physical ability for lifting, carrying and being on your feet most of the day.
- The ability to follow clear instructions without deviation.
- To work in a team under the supervision of a Team Leader.
- On site from 10:00AM Friday 24th July to 12:00PM Monday 27th July, 2026.

### **Daily pattern:**

- The team operates between 08:00 and 23:00.
- Shift lengths will vary from 3hrs to 7hrs. You may be required to work a split shift.
- You will have meal breaks and rest periods.



- You will be asked to help with set-up and pack-down.
