What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that can be exchanged with the browser when a user visits a particular website, allowing the web server to store information on the browser to be reused on the next visit. Cookies are stored, based on user preferences, by the individual browser on the specific device used (computer, tablet, mobile phone or other mobile device) or browser.

The cookies of the so-called "third parties" are, however, set by a website other than the one the User is visiting. This is because on each site there may be elements (images, maps, sounds, specific links to web pages of other domains, etc.) that reside on servers other than that of the site visited.

Cookies are used for different purposes: performing computer authentication, monitoring sessions, storing information on specific configurations regarding users who access the server, storing preferences, etc.

How many types of cookies are there?

There are different types of cookies, with different characteristics and uses:

- **Technical cookies:** these are essential cookies for the correct functioning of the site and are used to transmit a communication over an electronic communications network.

How does this Site use cookies?

This Site uses technical cookies to make use of the site more user-friendly. Among these it uses session cookies, which expire when the browser is closed.

- **.ASPXANONYMOUS**

This cookie is set by ASP.NET. The cookie is used to a unique ID for users to store tracking data within a session, anonymously.

- **ARRAffinity / ARRAffinitySameSite.**

This cookie is set by websites run on the Windows Azure cloud platform. It is used for load balancing to make sure the visitor page requests are routed to the same server in any browsing session.

- **session_timer**
This is used to time the session. It stores Start/End values.
- **__RequestVerificationToken**
This cookie is set by web application built in ASP.NET MVC Technologies. This is an anti-forgery cookie used for preventing cross site request forgery attacks.
- **.cmd**
To show the cookie accept message when load the site for first time
- **.tasalqw45564**
This cookie is to check if the browser has disabled cookies. If available, browser has enabled cookies. If not - we display warning message to enable the cookie.

Cookie permissions

Rights of the interested party

To guarantee correct and transparent processing of Personal Data, the list of rights that the interested party can exercise pursuant to articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR is reported:

- Request confirmation of the existence or otherwise of your personal data; access data concerning you at any time; obtain information regarding the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data, the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be communicated and, when possible, the retention period (art. 15);
- Obtain rectification or, if the data are processed in violation of the law or incomplete or incorrect, the cancellation of the data or blocking (articles 16-17);
- Obtain the limitation of processing (art. 18);
- Obtain data portability, i.e. receive them from a Data Controller, in a structured format, commonly used and readable by an automatic device, and transmit them to another Data Controller without impediments (art. 20);
- Object to the processing of your data at any time for legitimate reasons (art. 21);
- Oppose a fully automated decision-making process relating to natural persons, including profiling (art. 22).

The aforementioned rights can be exercised at any time by writing to the Data Controller, using the contact details above.
