Daytime Conference Attire

Men's Cool Biz Options

- Short or long sleeve dress shirts (white or pale blue, no tie) with lightweight chinos or dark slacks.
- Polo shirts, neat kariyushi (Okinawan style) or subdued patterned shirts permitted
- Skip the jacket unless the venue is air-conditioned and business formality is expected.
- Mirror-polished, lace-up dress shoes (easy-off for Japanese venues) and dark socks.
- Accessories: Leather briefcase, classic watch, subtle belt.









Daytime Conference Attire

Women's Cool Biz Options

- Blouses or lightweight tops (white, pastel, or subtle prints), paired with knee-length skirt or tailored trousers.
- Summer dress with light cardigan or blazer for added polish.
- Closed-toe pumps with low heel, nude or beige stockings if required.
- Minimal accessories: Leather tote, subtle jewelry











Evening Dinner Socials Formal/Semi-formal Adaptations

Men's Cool Biz Options

- Dark single-breasted suit (navy, charcoal, or black).
- Dress shirt (white or pale pastel), conservative tie optional for most dining events.
- Opt for a classic watch, cufflinks, and always polished shoes.







Evening Dinner Socials Formal/Semi-formal Adaptations

Women's Cool Biz Options

- Elegant cocktail dress, tailored pantsuit, or smart separates.
- Closed-toe heels or dressy flats, tasteful clutch, and understated jewelry.
- Avoid overly revealing or tight-fitting clothes, especially for fine dining venues

Fine Dining	Dark suit, dress shoes	Gown/pantsuit, low heels

Key Points for Japanese Cool Biz Attire at Medical Conferences

- Business casual prevails for daytime, but evening events require dressier, conservative attire.
- Respect local norms: Aim for simplicity, neatness, and professional impressions.
- Comfort and cultural appropriateness are central—
 Cool Biz allows for lighter clothing but always err on the side of formality for dinners.
- A thoughtful wardrobe following these guidelines will achieve both Cool Biz efficiency and the sophistication expected at a Japanese business events.
