	10:00-11:00	Fruit Picking	<p>Fruit picking is without a doubt one of Kurume's most popular tourist attractions. You can enjoy freshly picked fruit. Either eat them on-site or bring them home as a souvenir.</p> <p><b>White Grapes-Shine Muscat</b></p> <p>Shine Muscat picking is very popular every year. This high-end variety is seedless and can be eaten with the skin on. It has large yellow-green berries, crisp flesh texture, and distinct muscat flavor. Shine Muscat is a diploid table grape cultivar resulted from a cross of Akitsu-21 and 'Hakunan' (V. vinifera) made by National Institute of Fruit Tree Science (NIFTS) in Japan in 1988.</p> <p><i>As this is a seasonal activity which can be affected by climate change. In such cases, "pear picking" may be offered as an alternative.</i></p>
