Visitors can see up close the traditional techniques of Hakata textiles. At the end of the tour, there is time to purchase Hakata-ori items that are only available in the factory gift shop. 	11:05-11:50	Sasaguri Nanzoin	It is one of the largest bronze pieces in the world. (Total length 41 meters, Height 11 meters, Weight about 300 tons) It is a well-known story that the priest here won a large lottery prize and donated much of the money to charity. Many people receive the talismans at Daikokuten Hall because they won the lottery after wrapping their tickets in Daikokuten-sama's talismans.

	12:00-12:20	Yamaya Factory Terrace (Mentaiko factory)	The Yamaya Factory Terrace is a place where you can 'know', 'buy', 'eat' and 'experience' Mentaiko (Spicy Cod Roe). The Mentaiko Factory Tour is a fun way to learn about the production process of spicy cod roe through video and displays. Visitors can also see part of the actual factory through the factory tour window, and videos are available to show what they can't see. At the market you can also enjoy products that can only be tasted here, such as freshly made Mentaiko and the unusual Mentaiko soft ice cream.
