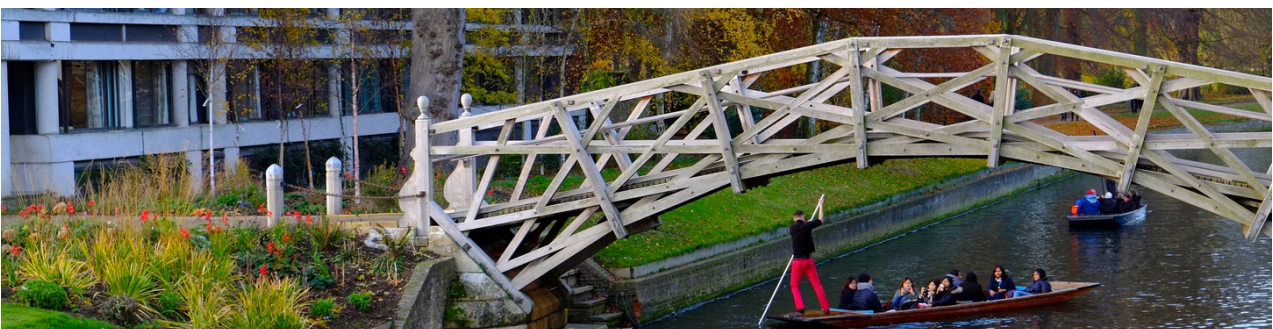


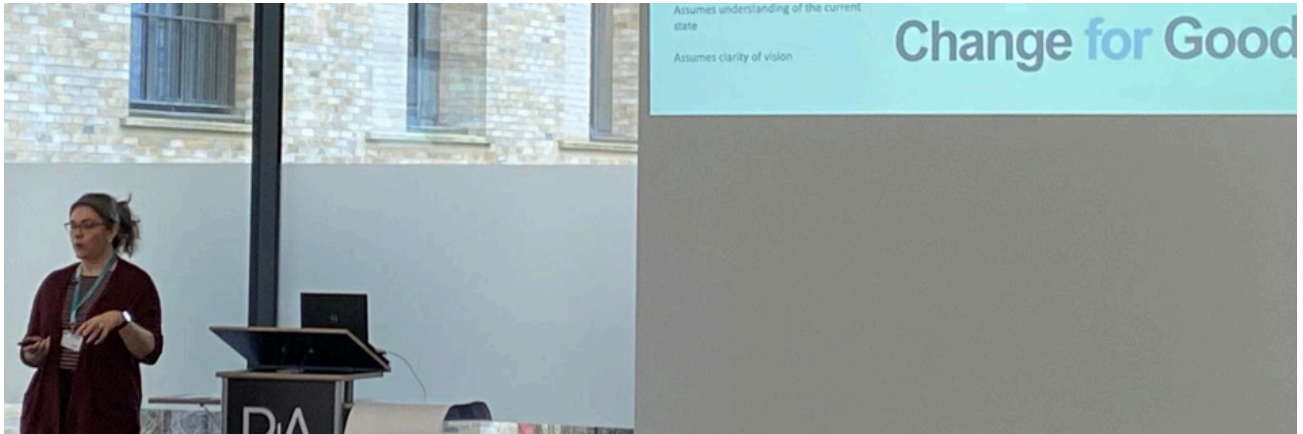
Hosted Visits
