



Poster Guidelines

Preparation:

- **Orientation & Size:** Posters must be in portrait orientation, with dimensions not exceeding 90 cm wide by 120 cm high.
- **Material:** Prepare your poster on a single sheet of material.
- **Legibility:** Ensure all text and illustrations are readable from 1–1.5 meters away. Sans serif fonts are recommended for better readability at a distance.
- **Title & Authors:** The top of the poster should display the title and authors exactly as stated in the submitted abstract.
- **Printing:** Authors must bring their printed posters to the conference or arrange local printing, as on-site printing facilities are not available at the venue. If you wish to print locally, the following copy shop can assist:

- **Handouts:** Consider providing handouts with reproductions of your poster, contact information, or a QR code linking to additional details about your research.

Display Instructions:

- **Location:** Posters will be displayed in the Poster Area on designated poster boards. Each board is numbered. Presenters should attach their posters to the board corresponding to the number assigned to their poster (see your communication for details).
- **Set-up:** Posters can be mounted from 8:00 AM on Thursday, 9 October. Velcro, double-sided tape, or tacks will be provided. Staff will be available to assist with mounting.
- **Dismantling:** Posters should remain on display until the end of the conference on Saturday, 11 October. Please remove your poster after the last session. Posters left behind will be discarded by the Conference Secretariat.
- **Display Period:** All posters will be on display from 9–11 October 2025.

Additional Notes:

- **Presenter Presence:** Presenters are encouraged to stay near their posters during breaks and scheduled viewing times to discuss their work with delegates.
- **Poster Viewing Sessions:** Three “Poster Viewing Sessions” have been added to the scientific programme. These sessions provide an opportunity to present your poster informally to delegates.
