To what extent has the PTPT demonstrated their commitment to successfully completing their PTPT qualification?

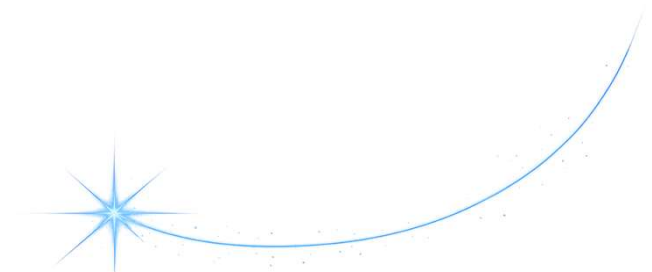
Please describe the academic achievements of the PTPT.

To what extent has the pharmacy technician made a significant contribution to Equality, Diversity & Inclusion?

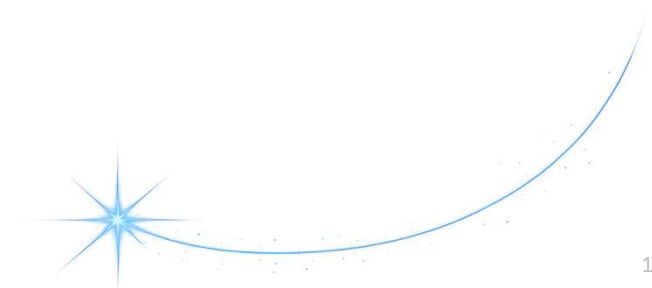
What impact has this Equality, Diversity & Inclusion contribution had for their team, patients or the public?

Katherine Miles Innovation Award

The Katherine Miles Innovation Award helps to support creative thinking. Entrants use posters or short oral presentations to illustrate latest research and generation of new and valuable ideas. There will be 2 awards given in 2026, one for the best poster presentation and one for the best oral presentation. The awards will be made to entrants who best showcase their projects, research or achievements.

What we want to hear about:

Study design – are the objectives, methods clearly written and is it a well-designed study?

Content - Is the overall abstract well-written and presented, does it make sense?

Impact – are the outcomes clear, is it a well conducted study, and will it influence practice?

The Rules

1

All entries must be written in English.

2

All entries must be submitted via our online entry system (include link).

3

All entries must be based on activities undertaken between April 2025 – April 2026.

4

Companies may enter more than one category, provided that each entry has been specifically written to address the relevant criteria.

5

All entries must include a picture of the nominee or team which can be used at the awards ceremony.

Confidentiality



We recognise and respect the sensitive nature of the information submitted in the entries.

We ensure that this recognition is shared by our judging panel as well.

Entries are not disclosed or discussed outside the judging process. Once an entry is shortlisted, extracts from the entry will be sourced for inclusion in the awards ceremony and any subsequent editorial coverage.

Assessment Criteria

Judges will evaluate nominations based on:

Impact: Contribution to pharmacy practice locally, regionally, nationally.

Innovation: Use of new methods, technology, or creative approaches.

Professionalism: Demonstration of ethical and professional standards.

Patient-Centred Outcomes: Evidence of improved care and service quality.

Leadership & Collaboration: For relevant categories, assess leadership qualities and teamwork.

FAQs

Q. How do I enter?

It's very simple. Ensure you have read the entry guidelines and category criteria. Decide which category/categories you wish to enter. Submit your entry via our online portal. Answer the questions/criteria relevant to your chosen category. When your entry is complete, don't forget to click submit.

Q. How much does it cost to enter?

It is free to enter the Awards.

Q. When is the entry deadline?

Entries are being accepted until 30th April 2026.

Q. I am not sure which category our entry would fit into?

If you are not sure which category your entry fits into, please contact our events team for further assistance aptuk@profileproductions.co.uk.

Q. Can I submit more than one entry?

Yes. Your business is able to enter as many as are relevant, please note you can't submit the same or similar entries for more than one category.

Q. I am a sponsor of the Awards. Am I still able to enter?

Yes, you can enter the Awards and we would encourage this. However, you are unable to enter the category you are sponsoring. But don't worry – there are plenty of other categories to choose from.

Q. How will I know whether my submission has been received?

All submissions will be acknowledged by an automated email once you have submitted your entry. Our Awards team will also get in touch with you again shortly after the entry deadline. If you have any concerns, please contact our events team aptuk@profileproductions.co.uk.

Q. How will I know if my submission has been successful?

Following the judging all shortlisted nominations will be informed via email by Friday 19th June 2026. The winners will be announced at the APTUK 2026 Professional Conference and Awards Dinner on Friday 18th September 2026, at the Renaissance Hotel, London Heathrow.

Q. What PR and marketing opportunities will there be if I am shortlisted?

All shortlisted entrants will be sent a marketing pack containing a digital email signature and banners to display on your website, social media and emails.

Q. What do I get if I win?

The APTUK Awards are highly regarded within the pharmacy profession and winning an award marks you out as a leader in your field. Winners are announced at the Awards ceremony and will receive an engraved trophy and an educational bursary towards attendance at APTUK Annual Conference 2027.

Q. How are nominations judged?

Each award has a clear table of criteria for the judges to follow, and their weight (%), aligned with the nomination questions (where provided) to reduce interpretation variance. A score is awarded using a consistent scoring rubric aligned with category-specific questions (e.g., extent of contribution, measurable outcomes).

Judges' decisions are final; no correspondence will be entered into regarding outcomes.
